Participant Requirements

Those interested in becoming an official, are to meet the below requirements:

- Be 16 years of age + and have a "skating background" defined by Skate Canada as
Any two of Junior Bronze Free Skating, Skills, Dance; or
Any one of Senior Bronze Free Skating, Skills, Dance or a Juvenile Competitive test; or
Any one higher level test.

Please Bring the Following Materials:

- clipboard and notepaper
- pencils and pens
- 3-ring binder
- Manuals/hand-outs (if required) will be provided at no charge and will be distributed at the clinic
- Bagged lunch or purchase lunch from concession

Registration Information & Cancellations

A \$50 (candidate) or \$10 (observer) registration deposit must be submitted with your registration. Deposits will only be processed if the participant does not attend, and fully complete the clinic.

Cancellations will be accepted up until 1 week prior to the clinic, with full refund. Clinics may be cancelled due to insufficient registrations. Clinics are accepting a maximum of 15 participants. Observer registrations will be accepted; based on space availability and at the discretion of the Section Evaluator/Judges Representative.
