2018 Arctic Winter Games

Team Alberta North is seeking energetic and enthusiastic individuals to participate as Mission Staff for the 2018 Arctic Winter Games being held March 17-24, 2018 in Hay River and Fort Smith, Northwest Territories. The Arctic Winter Games are a biennial celebration of sport and culture involving Alaska, Yukon, Northwest Territories, Nunavut, Alberta North, Nunavik (Northern Quebec), Greenland, Russia and the Sami of Northern Scandinavia.

The Mission Staff have a key role as members of Team Alberta North, acting as a liaison between individual sports and all components of the Arctic Winter Games organizational structure. Up to 9 Mission Staff members representing a blend of volunteers and professional staff from a wide cross section of the sport and recreation community in northern Alberta (Mission Staff must reside north of the 55th parallel) will be selected. Mission Staff members are volunteers who do not receive payment for their services or compensation for time off work. Travel, meals and accommodation to and from the Games will be reimbursed as per the Alberta Sport Connection Travel Policy. Mission Staff are required to attend all mission meetings and must be available for the duration of the Games. A brief overview of specific qualifications and responsibilities is enclosed along with the application form.

We are asking for your assistance in distributing the enclosed application to anyone within your network who may be qualified and interested in becoming a member of Team Alberta North's Mission Staff for the 2018 Arctic Winter Games.

Applications including a resume and a letter of support must be received by **Monday**, **April 17**, **2017**.

- Strong interpersonal, communication and organizational skills
- High energy, positive attitude and multi-task oriented

All applications must be received by **April 17**, **2017**. Final selection and notification will occur by June 2017. Applicants may be called upon for a personal or telephone interview and be required to submit a police records check before their position is confirmed.



MISSION STAFF RESPONSIBILITIES

The Alberta Mission Staff provide the primary link between all components of the Games' organizational structure and the sports to which they are assigned. Mission Staff are the key contacts for the sports leading up to, during and immediately following the Games. This approach enables Alberta's athletes, coaches and managers to concentrate on training and the competition at the Games.

Pre-Games

- Attend Mission Staff meetings and a two day retreat (mandatory)
 - November 16-18 or 23-25, 2017 Mission Staff Meeting/Retreat
 - February 9, 2018 Mission Staff Meeting (Grande Prairie)
- Become familiar with the structure and organization of Team Alberta North as well as the Arctic Winter Games and Team Alberta North rules and guidelines, including eligibility, Code of Conduct, registration, etc.
- Gain clear understanding of the technical package and all regulations affecting your assigned sports' involvement in the Arctic Winter Games including protest procedures
- Provide link between the Alberta Sport Connection and sport coordinator and coaches/managers
- Communicate pertinent Arctic Winter Games and Team Alberta North information to the sport coordinators and coaches/managers, field questions, provide clarification and assist with issues if they arise
- Assist the Alberta Sport Connection, sport coordinator and coaches/managers with administrative requirements, e.g. registration, media profile forms, travel arrangements, etc. and other related duties as needed
- Attend training/selection events prior to the Arctic Winter Games to become familiar with team staff and athletes
- Attend a Team Alberta North Staging event
 - February 10, 2018 Grande Prairie
 - February 13, 2018 Fort McMurray (for Mission Staff in Fort McMurray only)

At the Games

- Attend coaches/technical meetings and provide updates to the Chef de Mission
- Attend daily Mission Staff meetings
- Attend competitions for assigned sports
- Perform Mission desk duty as assigned
- Daily input to the Team Alberta North Social Media program and results system
- Check sport results for accuracy on a regular basis
- Assist coaches/managers with administrative details and communicate to them all matters related to Arctic Winter Games policies and procedures
- Assist coaches/managers with protest procedures if required
- Assist with emergency situations and issues to ensure athletes/coaches concentrate on their competition
- Minimum 11 day commitment during the Arctic Winter Games
 - March 15 25, 2018

Post-Games

- Complete a Mission Staff Post Games questionnaire/report
- Follow up on any matters with the sports resulting from the Games
- Attend Post-Games Evaluation Meeting
 - April 2018
