

Creating the Edge for Life Award AdultSkate Award

This award is presented to an adult skater who pushes themselves towards new goals, continues to challenge their ability, and raises the standard in Adult Skating. This adult displays good sportsmanship and inspires skaters of all ages and levels to continue developing their own skating abilities. Award recipients will be selected by the Section Awards Selection Committee. This award will be presented to one individual at the Skate Canada: Alberta – NWT/Nunavut Awards Banquet.

Eligibility Criteria - the nomination must meet the following requirements in order to be eligible:

- Registered member of Skate Canada as an Adult Skater (18 years of age or older) for the current season in which the nomination is being submitted;
- The competitions results are based on the past calendar year;
- Skate Canada Test results are tests that are passed as an adult skater; and
- Skater must reside in Alberta, NWT or Nunavut, and be a member of a Skate Canada: Alberta NWT/Nunavut Club or Skating School.

The nomination must highlight a minimum of <u>one</u> of the following areas of achievement:

- Passed tests through Skate Canada as an Adult skater.
- Participated in an adult category in a competition at a local, national, and/or international level.
- Performed in skating productions or ice shows.

The following information is required for submission:

- Nominee's personal information and Skate Canada number.
- Why this skater should be considered for the award.
- Details of the nominee's specific achievements (dates of tests passed, dates and names of competitions, ice show performances, etc.).
- Details of other involvement about the nominee that you would like the selection committee to be aware of (attending seminars, volunteering, etc.).

In addition to this form, nominators are encouraged to submit letters of support written by skaters, parents, etc. A maximum of three (3) additional supporting documents may be attached. If you would like to submit more, please combine multiple files and submit them as a single document. All submissions must be submitted *online* no later than <u>February 15th of each year</u>.
