Gateway Skating Club Post-Secondary Bursary

The purpose of the Gateway Skating Club Post-Secondary Bursary award is to encourage skaters to continue competing while pursuing post-secondary education in keeping with the principles of Canadian Sport for Life. The recipient will be selected based on criteria that captures the individual's dedication to the training required to compete, while achieving their educational goals at the same time. Award recipients will be selected by the Section Awards Selection Committee. This award will be presented to one individual at the Skate Canada: Alberta – NWT/Nunavut Awards Banquet.

Eligibility Criteria - the nomination must meet the following requirements in order to be eligible:

- Pursuing full-time post-secondary education at an approved institution in Alberta, NWT or Nunavut in the same year as the candidate is nominated for the award
 - The institution must be on the list of approved schools named in the Post-Secondary Learning Act in Alberta or its equivalent in NWT or Nunavut
 - Full-time attendance will be as confirmed by the institution
 - Evidence of a passing standard in the program of studies will be required
- Competing in either STARSkate Championships, Sectionals or Adult competitions during the current competitive season
- Displays spirit and passion for the sport
- Gives back to the sport at the Club, Region or Section level
- Is a registered member of the Alberta – NWT/Nunavut Section for the current season

The following information is required for submission:

- Nominee's personal and Skate Canada information
- Details of the nominee's contributions to the sport at the Club, Region, and/or Section level
- Description of the individual's passion and spirit for the sport

Please attach evidence of the passing standard being met. In addition to this form, nominators are encouraged to submit letters of support written by skaters, parents, etc. A maximum of three (3) additional supporting documents may be attached. If you would like to submit more, please combine multiple files and submit them as a single document. All submissions must be submitted **online** no later than **February 15th of each year**.
