



Spirit and Passion of Skating Award AdultSkate Award

This award is presented to an adult skater that is passionate about the sport of figure skating and through their enthusiasm, motivates and encourages other adults to follow their dreams. This skater is also a positive role model to skaters of all ages and demonstrates that the dream to skate, or continue to skate, is possible. Award recipients will be selected by the Section Awards Selection Committee. This award will be presented to one individual at the Skate Canada: Alberta – NWT/Nunavut Awards Banquet.

Eligibility Criteria - the nomination must meet the following requirements in order to be eligible:

- Registered member of Skate Canada as an Adult Skater (18 years of age or older) for the current season in which the nomination is being submitted;
- Skater must reside in Alberta, NWT, or Nunavut, and be a member of a Skate Canada: Alberta – NWT/Nunavut Club or Skating School.

The nomination must highlight a minimum of one of the following areas of achievement:

- Overcoming personal obstacles
- Perseverance
- Volunteering at the Club and/or Section level
- Promotes skating

The following information is required for submission:

- Nominee's personal and Skate Canada information.
- Details of the achievement that the nominee has accomplished

In addition to this form, nominators are encouraged to submit letters of support written by skaters, parents, etc. A maximum of three (3) additional supporting documents may be attached. If you would like to submit more, please combine multiple files and submit them as a single document. All submissions must be submitted **online** no later than **February 15th of each year**.
