Facility

- Team Buses arriving are asked to drop-off/pick-up teams in the east parking lot. There is also space in the east parking lot for them to park.
- Please use the assigned warm-up space for your teams. Warming-up is not allowed in the public areas of the facility.

Registration

- Registration will open 1 hour before the first practice ice/event.
- Accreditation tags for skaters, team managers and chaperones will be in the team bags you receive at registration. In an effort to be environmentally friendly, please return accreditation tags at the end of the competition to the registration desk.
- Coaches will receive their accreditation tags when registering at the registration desk.

General

- Small cups of water will be provided to the skaters in the kiss and cry area.
- A photo booth will be available for teams and families located near the Sobeys arena. Props will be available to use.
- Video order requests will be accepted at the registration desk. Videos will be put on a USB stick to be picked up at the registration desk.

Opening Ceremonies and Medal Ceremonies

- Team banners may be posted within the Sobeys arena
- Team lineups for the medal ceremonies are posted on the section website as well as provided in your team bag.
- For those teams receiving medals, coaches will also be presented with a medal.

Vendors

- Photos will be available to purchase by On-Site Photography. They will be photographing teams on the ice and in the kiss and cry.
- Leduc Physio will be on site Saturday and Sunday to offer services to the athletes. Please see the attached poster.

Reminder

- Coaches must notify the Technical Representative if your team is practicing or competing with fewer than your regular number of skaters (due to illness or injury) to avoid penalties to elements in your program(s). If a skater becomes ill or injured in the dressing room immediately prior to taking the ice, the coach must notify the Ice Level Referee
