Bonnyville Skating Club is seeking to hire an enthusiastic and highly motivated CanSkate coach for the 2018-19 skating season!

We are a not-for-profit, amateur athletic association affiliated with Skate Canada for over 40 years. Our club programs operate out of the Centennial Centre's Cenovus arena in Bonnyville, Alberta from late August to the end of March. We have approximately 60 skaters in our CanSkate program.

KEY AREAS OF RESPONSIBILITY:

- Oversee and manage all aspects of our CanSkate program in accordance to Skate Canada's program delivery standards
- Tailor the delivery of the curriculum to meet the needs of skater's development
- Complete mid-year and post season Skater Progress Reports
- Coordinate Program Assistants and Helpers
- Participate in club events associated with CanSkate programming ie: Carnival and Fun Meet
- Attend monthly club executive meetings

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND BEHAVIOUR REQUIRED:

- Hold a minimum of Club Coach In-Training/Trained/Certified status in good standing with Skate Canada. Regional Coach In-Training/Trained/Certified candidates may also be considered
- Knowledge, understanding and experience working with children of various ages
- Strong team leadership skills
- High level communication and interpersonal skills to effectively work with our coaching team, Program Assistants and Helpers, club executive members and skating families
- Ability to diagnose skater skill level and plan appropriate training sessions to maximize development in line with Skate Canada's curriculum standards
- Willingness to further coaching knowledge with continuing education training courses
- Be organized, punctual, and reliable

REMUNERATION:

Remuneration dependent on skill level, experience and education. The club is committed to investing in our coaches and will offer opportunities to attend course training. Compensation amounts for professional development are based on years of service to the club.
