<p>Roles & Responsibilities</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • As a Calalta regional coach, will accept Star 1-4 skaters for private lessons and then once the skater moves to Star 5 or Pre-Juvenile, will transfer that skater to our Nationally trained and/or Nationally certified coaches; • Must be able to partner successfully with National coaches in the transition of skater; • This is a 'feeder' system for the coaches at the National Trained and/or National certified level; • Must be available as a primary coach with a focus on Star 1-4 skaters and take skaters to competitions; • This role is based out of Jimmie Condon arena.
