## **Use and Transportation of Equipment Policy**

The Section CPC and music equipment is insured on a yearly basis by Skate Canada: Alberta-NWT/Nunavut solely for the equipment during transport and on site at competitions and events. The Section CPC and music equipment is only available for member Clubs and Partner User groups within the Alberta-NWT/Nunavut Section.

For transportation of the Section CPC and music equipment, one of the following two options must be met.

- 1. Transportation by personal vehicle:
  - Individual must be minimum age of 21 years old and must have a minimum of a full Class 5 Driver's License (Class 5 GDL Driver's License is not permitted);
  - Individual must produce a photocopy of third party personal injury and vehicle collision insurance with minimum \$1,000,000 coverage.
- 2. Transportation by rental vehicle;
  - Individual must produce a photocopy of third party personal injury and vehicle collision insurance with minimum \$1,000,000 coverage.
  - Individual must produce a photocopy of the rental agreement.

**NOTE:** The Section Office requires photocopies of the above mentioned documents on file.

The individual(s) transporting the Section CPC and music equipment is responsible to ensure that they have third party personal injury and vehicle collision insurance with minimum \$1,000,000 coverage in the event of an accident during transportation of the equipment. In the event of an accident, the individual's primary personal insurance may be applicable first and then the Skate Canada insurance (if applicable) would be secondary. Any applicable deductible for both insurance companies may apply and would be the responsibility of the individual transporting the equipment. It is recommended that the individual notify the insurance provider of the volunteer activity before the transportation of the CPC and/or Music Equipment occurs.

In certain situations, Section office may approve the transport of specific pieces of CPC and music equipment by shipping through a courier. Approval to transport equipment via courier is dependent on the amount of equipment requested to be shipped, the value of the equipment and the required insurance coverage in place. In addition, the member Club/Partner User is responsible for all shipping costs and any additional insurance coverage that may apply through the courier company. Any request to transport CPC and music equipment through a courier is to be directed to Section office.
