Timing Correct timing throughout	Skater must demonstrate the ability to perform all the steps on time throughout the entire pattern dance. Only one								
	(1) timing error is permitted through the assessment. A timing error is the period from which the dance is incorrect ("off time") until it is corrected. This period maybe be one or more steps/turns. If a timing error occurs, the skater should make every attempt to return to the correct timing. Skating on the weak beat (wrong strong beat) is a serious error and is incorrect timing.
