**Current Officials:** The clinic can be used as a refresher for judges or as a 3-year update.

This is an opportunity to learn how to assess and judge in the new STAR program. This training clinic will give you an opportunity to trial some events through viewing videos, participate in discussions and obtain feedback.

### **Participant Requirements**

Those interested in becoming an official, are to meet the below requirements:

- Be 16 years of age + and have a "skating background" defined by Skate Canada as  
Any two of Junior Bronze Free Skating, Skills, Dance; or  
Any one of Senior Bronze Free Skating, Skills, Dance or a Juvenile Competitive test; or  
Any one higher level test.

Selected applicants will be contacted in early February to confirm attendance. Accepted participants will be encouraged to attend a STARSkate competition prior to the clinic (Grande Prairie, Drayton Valley, Sylvan Lake). Participants will be on a headset to get a firsthand view of the STAR judging process. Arrangements will be made in advance of the competition with the Tech Rep to confirm your participation. Candidates are encouraged to spend a couple hours taking in the STAR judging process at a competition to better prepare for the training.

Clinics may be cancelled due to insufficient registrations. Clinics are accepting a maximum of 15 participants. Observer registrations will be accepted; based on space availability and at the discretion of the Section Evaluator/Judges Representative.
