



Section Coach Achievement Award

The purpose of the Skate Canada: Alberta – NWT/Nunavut Coach Achievement Award is to recognize the dedication and achievements of Skate Canada coaches within the Section. The recipient will be selected for their unique and outstanding contributions to their club, athletes and the Section. The recipient will be selected by the Skate Canada: Alberta – NWT/Nunavut Awards Selection Committee. This award will be presented to one individual at the Skate Canada: Alberta – NWT/Nunavut Awards Banquet.

Eligibility Criteria - *the nomination must meet the following requirements in order to be eligible:*

- An active professional coach who is currently registered with Skate Canada with a minimum NCCP CanSkate Trained, as a member in good standing;
- A coach who is keen to share accurate information with officials, athletes, coaches, parents and administrators with the interest/intent of developing figure skating and figure skaters in their club or Section; and
- A coach who has shown commitment to professional development through continued upgrading of qualifications throughout the skating season.

The nomination must highlight a minimum of one of the following areas of achievement:

- A coach who has demonstrated exceptional coaching and athlete management skills in helping their athlete(s) achieve a personal best performance, notable improvement or competitive result.
- A coach who has made a significant contribution to a team or athlete's performance.
- Achieved a significant milestone in the coach and athlete/team's career during the current skating season in which the nomination is being submitted.
- Assisted the club in achieving a significant milestone pertaining to the development of skaters and/or the club's programs.
- Demonstrates a volunteer commitment to their club and/or community

The following information is required for submission:

- Nominee's personal and Skate Canada information.
- An explanation of the individual's area(s) of achievement and why they should be selected to receive this award.
- Details of the nominee's significant contribution to their skaters and their club if applicable.
- Details of their professional development activities (committees, courses, seminars, etc).

In addition to this form, nominators are encouraged to submit letters of support written by skaters, parents, etc. A maximum of three (3) additional supporting documents may be attached. If you would like to submit more, please combine multiple files and submit them as a single document.
