#### **Standards of Assessment**

### **Mandatory Requirements**

**1-Foot Turn Sequence:** Contains minimum 4 turns, ice coverage must be minimum  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the ice

Field Moves: Meets definition of field move(s)

Step Sequence: Minimum 4 different turns, ice coverage must be minimum ¾ of the ice (any pattern)

Skills Exercise: Meets definition of step & turn sequence and stable throughout (no fall)
