Sheena volunteered for over 40 years with Skate Canada as a judge, referee, technical controller, evaluator and clinic leader. Sheena became a judge in 1975, and over the years she developed a rich history of volunteerism. Whenever the call went out to serve, Sheena readily accepted the task.

At the Section level Sheena served as Judges Chair and Skater Development Chair. At the national level she served on the National Judges Committee and Skater Development Committees. She also served

on the International Judges Committee.

In 1982, Sheena received her Canadian promotion and judged at the National Championships for the next 25 years in a row. In 1988, Sheena received her International promotion and had her passport stamped in countries all over the world as she officiated at dozens of events.

Sheena's knowledge and dedication greatly benefited the athletes. She gave countless hours to monitoring skaters in Alberta and across Canada. She had many special moments watching the skaters grow, gain experience and reach their goals. Sheena considers the time spent judging on panels, monitoring athletes, and being a part of the Kurt Browning era to be the highlights of her officiating career.
