- *Will be required to keep up with coach certification, attending clinics, seminars, as well as any other continuing educations*
- *Be a Skate Canada registered coach In Good Standing*
- *Provide a copy of your coach dashboard*

Roles & Responsibilities:

- *Required to follow the conduct guidelines set out by Skate Canada*
- *Assess skaters, write report cards, provide incentives with badges and ribbons*
- *Take attendance and keep track of lessons received*
- *Provide a safe, fun, and rich learning environment for the skaters*
- *Help organize and attend yearly carnival*
- *Work alongside skaters/parents when hosting and attending competitions*
- *Provide the skaters with learning opportunities to progress in their skill levels*
- *Will be required to provide training, and keeping attendance for Program Assistants*
- *Set up ice and draw circuits to facilitate learning per Skate Canada standards*
