

# 2022-2023 Junior Development Team Criteria



## **Singles:**

Pre-Juvenile U11 Women: Top 6 Pre-Juvenile U11 Men: Top 6

Pre-Juvenile U13 Women: Top 2 from the STARSkate Championship

Pre-Juvenile U13 Men: Top 2

Juvenile U12 Women: Top 6 Juvenile U12 Men: Top 6

Juvenile U14 Women: Top 2 Juvenile U14 Men: Top 2

Pre-Novice Women: Top 3 placements NOT qualifying for Challenge. Pre-Novice Men: Top 3 placements NOT qualifying for Challenge.

#### Wild Cards – Pre-Juvenile U11 and Juvenile U12 Women and Men:

Skaters who demonstrate exceptional skills and who are U10 as of July 1, 2022 (Pre-Juvenile), or who are U11 as of July 1, 2022 (Juvenile), will be considered for the JDT.

Also, any skater who ATTEMPTS a double axel or higher, with a maximum rotational deficit of a "q" while competing at the Sectional Championship, will automatically be added to the JDT.

# Wild Cards - Juvenile U14 Women:

After the top 2 placements, the next 3 skaters with the highest point totals who are U13 as of July 1, 2022, AND have achieved a minimum score of 22 points, will be added to the JDT.

### Wild Cards - Pre-Novice Women and Men:

After the top 3 placements <u>not</u> qualifying for Challenge, the next 3 skaters with the highest combined point totals who are U13 as of July 1, 2022, AND have achieved a minimum score of 62 points (Women) or 50 points (Men), will be added to the JDT.

Also, any skater who LANDS a double axel or higher, with a maximum rotational deficit of a "q while competing at the Sectional Championship, will automatically be added to the JDT.
