Facility

Parking: Parking at the facility is free. It is suggested to enter the building through Entrance 2.

Spectators: Spectators are welcome. There is no fee to watch the event.

Raffle: The Fliteway Skating Club is hosting an in-person Raffle table. Help support skaters by purchasing tickets with your chance to be the lucky winner of one or more great prizes. Raffle Prizes will be drawn at the end of the Competition.

Danielle Earl Photography: Danielle Earl Photography will be at the event taking professional photos. Danielle goes around the world taking photos of figure skaters and her photos are beautiful! Vendor: there will be a vendor onsite in the lobby area in front of arena B selling clothing.

Event Reminders

- **Warm-up Area:** There is no designated warm-up area, however, we suggest warming up in the area between Arena A & Arena B on the second floor.
- **Music CD's:** Skaters' must bring their back-up CD's to the ice with them – CD's are not being collected at the registration table.
- **Schedule/Start Order/Results/Report Cards:** The schedule and start orders are now posted on the website. The schedule and start orders will also be posted on-site in the dressing room hallways. Report cards and results will NOT be provided onsite, except for Star 4 report cards which will be handed out at the registration desk approximately 30 minutes after the completion of each flight. Results will be posted on the website only.
- **Withdraw Form:** The online form must be used to submit any withdraws from the event. The form is posted on the Section website on the event page.

- **Protest/Clarification Form:** The online form must be used to submit any protests/clarifications. The form is posted on the Section website on the event page.
- **Medal Presentations:** Medals will be presented at the event. A medal presentation schedule will be posted near the medal presentation area. **There will be medals presented for StarSkate and Adult Championships and the Leading-Edge Series. Skaters are required to wear their skates and skating attire for the medal presentations.**
- **Live Stream:** Both arenas will be live streamed. The links will be provided on the main page of the Skate AB/NT/NU website.
- **Purchase Your Skaters Video:** You may purchase your skater's performance by submitting your request using the online form available on the event page of the website.
- **2023 StarSkate and Adult Merit Award:** The Alberta Figure Skating Foundation is proud to support the Merit Award. The Merit Award is selected amongst the Officials at the event to recognize a memorable or outstanding performance (singles, pair, and dance). The Alberta Figure Skating Foundation awards a \$250 bursary to the recipient. The recipient will be announced at the final medal presentation of the event on Sunday afternoon.
- **Dressing Rooms Power outlets:** We ask that you do not use any of the power outlets inside the dressing rooms.
- **Club/Skating School Stars:** on the second floor between arena A & B, there will be stars on the wall for each club/skating school. There will be markers available for skaters to write good luck messages on them!

COACH Specific Information

- If your skater ends up handing in their back-up CD on the ice, the CD's will be placed at the registration desk and the skater or an assigned coach from the skaters' club may pick up the CD.
- **Coach Hospitality Room:** Dressing room B1 located in the practice arena (Arena B) is available for coaches' hospitality. Coffee, tea, and a small assortment of snacks will be provided (bananas, assorted granola bars.) There is NO fee.
- **Coach Meeting:** There will not be a coach meeting.
- **Coach ID tags:** Coaches MUST check in at the registration desk and collect their ID tag. If you have a lanyard from before, please bring that to place your new ID tag insert. Coaches must comply by their certification levels to be rink-side.
