All entries must be received **NO LATER** than November 9, 2023 12:00 PM (noon) MST. It is the responsibility of the competitor to ensure that their entry is submitted by the closing date.

5. **Entry Fee:** Clubs are to bring one club cheque on Dec. 3, 2023. Please hand in at the Registration Desk. There will be a \$25 charge on any NSF cheques received.

6. Event Schedule

7. Refund of Entry Fees

Entry fees shall be refunded only if the event is not held. There will be no refunds given for any reason, including medical pulls.

8. Music

STAR 2 / 3 Freeskate Music Submissions

Music must be saved as the skater's first and last name (i.e., John Smith)

Deadline for music submission is November 18, 2023

All skaters must bring back-up music:

Two copies of the participant's music must be handed in at the Registration Table. Music must be on CDs, and each CD must have only one program on it and must be clearly labelled with skater's name, event, club and length of program. Skaters are responsible for the recovery of their own music at the completion of the event.

9. On-Site Registration

Skaters must register a minimum of one hour prior to the start of their scheduled event. Skaters must report to the Ice Captain one hour prior to their scheduled event.

10. Marking System

CanSkate ELEMENT EVENT categories will be assessed in accordance with the CanSkate Element Event Technical Package

Star 1-3 will be judged as per the Star Standards for Assessment Guide

11. Awards / Presentations

These will be held every hour, with the first presentation at 10:00. It is the responsibility of the skaters to wear their skates & skating attire for the presentations. Please remember to bring your skate guards.

12. Event Specifications

CanSkate categories will combine boys and girls by stage and age.

In normal circumstances, Star 1-3 categories offered at competitions will be held for men and women separately. The decision to combine categories is at the discretion of the Competition Chair with the input of the host committee. Categories may be combined, due to low entries for either age categories or combined male/female events.

13. Warm Up Times

Skate Canada has standardised warm up times for all events.

14. Accidents

The Association and Committee of the Host Club undertake no responsibility for damages or injuries suffered by the skater. As a condition of and in consideration of their entries in this event, all competitors and their parents or guardians shall be deemed to release any and all claims they may have against the Officicals, the Association, the Host Club and their officers. Entries shall be only in accordance with these conditions.

15. Pictures & Video

Persons wishing to take photographs of on ice performances are reminded that the use of flash cameras is NOT permitted. The use of video cameras must be restricted to areas that do not hamper the skater or officials. NOTE: You may ONLY take photos or videos of your own skater.
