GENERAL INFORMATION

The event is being held following the CanSkate Element Technical Package and Star Event Standard for Assessment Guide.

CATEGORIES: The following Categories are to be held:

- CanSkate Elements
- CanSkate Creative Improv
- Pre-Star Spin, Spiral, Jump, Creative Event
- Star 2/3 Freeskate

ENTRY FEES:

CanSkate Creative Improv Stage 5 and 6	\$25 PER SKATER
Pre-Star Spin, Spiral, Jump, Creative Event	\$40 PER SKATER
Star 2/3 Freeskate	\$60 PER SKATER

Entries: Entrants in Events shall be:

- Eligible persons as defined in Skate Canada Rule Book Section 2100
- Be Associate members in good standing of the Association. All event entries will be accepted only from skaters who are members of affiliated Skate Canada clubs.

*Registration forms **MUST BE COMPLETED IN FULL** or they may not be processed!

CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES: All entries must be registered online no later than **December 31, 2023**. It is the responsibility of the skater to ensure that their entry is in to the Host Committee Registration person by the closing date.

LATE ENTRIES: **There will be absolutely no late entries accepted after the deadline. No exceptions.**

REFUND OF ENTRY FEES: Entry fees shall be refunded *only* if the event is not held. There will be no refunds given for any reason, including medical pulls. No exceptions.

REGISTRATION ON DAY OF EVENT: Skaters must register at least one hour prior to their scheduled Category or practice. Skaters must report to the Ice Captain one hour prior to their scheduled Category.

SCHEDULE AND CANCELLATION OF EVENTS: The host club reserves the right to cancel events or limit the number of entries due to time constraints or ice availability. Schedule will be posted on our website www.stettlerskatingclub.com and sent out via email.

ACCIDENTS:

The Association and Committee of the Host Club undertake no responsibility for damages or injuries suffered by the skater. As a condition of and in consideration of their entries in these Events, all skaters and their parents or guardians shall be deemed to agree to assume all risks or injuries to the skaters person and property resulting from, or caused by, or connected with the conduct and management of the events. An agreement must also be deemed to release any and all claims they may have against the officials, the Association, the Host Club, and their officers. Entries shall be accepted only in accordance with these conditions.

AWARDS: Skaters will receive a Gold, Silver or Bronze medal. The awards ceremony for each flight will be held approximately 15-minutes after the conclusion of each event in the awards area.

PICTURES & VIDEOS: Persons wishing to take photographs of on ice performances are reminded that use of flash cameras is forbidden. The use of video cameras must be restricted to areas that do not hamper the skaters. You may only take pictures or videos of your own skater.

CANSKATE ELEMENTS EVENT

Elements are to be skated as elements in isolation.

*Note that skills are integrated, if a skater has passed Stage 1 they would enter in Stage 2.

Stage 1:

Snow Slide Steps
Fwd Push/Glide Sequence
2 ft Jump
Bwd 2 ft Skating/walking

Stage 2:

Fwd Stop
Fwd 2 ft Sculling
Fwd 2 ft Turn (CW or CCW – skater's choice)
Bwd 2 ft Sit Glide

Stage 3:

Fwd Circle Thrusts (CW or CCW – skater's choice)
Bwd 2 ft Jump
2 ft Quick Turn Fwd – Bwd and Bwd – Fwd (CW or CCW – skater's choice)
Bwd 2 ft Sculling

Stage 4:

Bwd Circle Thrusts (CW or CCW - skater's choice)
Bwd 360 degree Step Turn (CW or CCW - skater's choice)
2 ft Jump Fwd – Bwd and Bwd – Fwd (CW or CCW - Skater's choice)
Fwd Inside Slalom

Stage 5:

Fwd 2-ft Side Stop (CW or CCW - skater's choice)
Bwd Push/Glide Sequence, Full Perimeter (CW or CCW - Skater's choice)
Fwd Power Jump
Fwd Crosscuts - Figure-8

Stage 6:

Fwd 1-ft Side Stop (L or R - skater's choice)
Bwd Perimeter Skating with Crosscuts (CW or CCW - determined by draw)
Fwd 180° Step Turn (C-Step) (RFI-LBI or LFI-RBI - Skater's choice)
Fwd Outside Edges

CANSKATE CREATIVE IMPROV: Stages 5 and 6

Skaters will hear a piece of music selected by the host club twice in warm up. They will perform a creative routine on the ice to the music selected. Program length should not exceed 1:00 minute. Skaters must have passed Stage 4 CanSkate. Skaters will be categorized by age and level. Routines will be assessed based on skating skills, interpretation, and performance and execution.

PRE-STAR SPIN, SPIRAL, JUMP CREATIVE EVENT

*For skater(s) who have not passed any Star tests

*Skaters will hear a piece of music selected by the host club twice in warm-up. They will then perform their trained creative routine to the music selection. Routine music is 1:30min in length.

- A Jump of any nature
- A Spin of any nature
- A Spiral of any nature
- Skating skills
- Performance
