# FEES

#### ENTRIES

#### Entrants in Events shall be:

- a) Eligible persons as defined in Skate Canada Rule Book Section 2100
- b) Be Associate members in good standing of the Association. All event entries will be accepted only from skaters who are members of affiliated Skate Canada clubs.

#### **CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES**

All entries must be registered online no later than **May 16, 2024 by 12pm MST**. It is the responsibility of the skater to ensure that their entry is in to the Host Committee Registration person by the closing date. Crowfoot skaters will receive priority registration between April 20-30, 2024. **Registration will open to all Calgary clubs on April 12, 2024 at 9:00 AM**.

#### LATE ENTRIES

There will be absolutely no late entries accepted after the deadline. No exceptions.

#### WITHDRAWAL/REFUND OF ENTRY FEES

Entry fees shall be refunded only if the event is not held. Any changes or withdrawals may be requested **before** the closing date and will occur a fee of \$10. No refunds will be made after the closing date (May 16) for any reason, including medical pulls. No exceptions.

#### AWARDS

It is the responsibility of ALL skaters receiving an award to wear their skates and skating attire for the awards presentation. Awards will be ongoing all day long. Everyone goes home a winner!

#### **PICTURES & VIDEOS**

Persons wishing to take photographs of on-ice performances are reminded that use of flash cameras is forbidden. The use of video cameras must be restricted to areas that do not hamper the skaters. **NOTE:** You may only take pictures or videos of your own skater. No parents will be allowed in the player's box area.

Individual element event. Each skater will perform each element in isolation and skaters will take turns within their group. Skaters must have passed Stage 6 CanSkate but must not have passed the complete Star 3 level of assessments. Skaters will be assessed to standard as per the Star 1-4 Event Standards for Assessment Guide. <i>Coaches please note this is not the same as</i> <i>traditional Star 1, only the 4 elements will be</i> <i>performed as they will have the opportunity to</i> <i>be creative in the creative event!</i>	Skaters must have passed Stage 6 CanSkate but must not have passed the complete Star 3 level of assessments. Skaters will be assessed to standard as per the Star 1-4 Event Standards for Assessment Guide.	Creative Improv programs are offered in a singles format and are designed only by the skater with minimal preparation. There is no coaching permitted for these events. Designated volunteers will be responsible for each group to bring the skaters to and from the dressing room to the ice. All the skaters in a given flight for an event are presented with a pre- selected piece of music prior to the warm- up. All skaters in the flight for that event will perform to the same musical selection. Skaters will listen to the music twice off-ice in a designated area (i.e. dressing room) and twice on-ice during the 4 min warm-up period.	Teams must be comprised of 2 to 4 skaters.
