Awards:	Skaters will receive a scoresheet and a Gold, Silver or Bronze ribbon

	The awards ceremony for each flight will be held approximately 20 minutes     after the conclusion of each event in the lobby
Evaluators/Judge:	The event is being held under the current Skate AB I NT I NU and the Star 1-3 Competition guidelines and will include 1 Skate AB I NT I NU Judge.
Warm-Up Times:	Skate Canada has standardized warm-up times for events.
