Senior – Singles No Age / Pair No Age / Dance No Age

Synchronized Skating Categories – Skaters Age as of July 1, 2024

Star 3 Elements – No Age requirement
Star 4 - Age grouping may be used only if numbers warrant. Option 1: No age restriction. Option 2: At least 75% of skaters must not have reached the age of 12 as of July 1st preceding the competition. (U12). Option 3: at least 75% of skaters must have reached the age of 12 as of July 1st preceding the competition. (O12)
Star 6 - Must not have reached the age of 15, at least 75% must not have reached the age of 13
Star 8 - Must not have reached the age of 18
Gold - Must not have reached the age of 19
Open - Must have reached the age of 15
Novice - Must have reached the age of 10 but must not have reached the age of 16
Junior - Must have reached the age of 13 but must not have reached the age of 19
Senior - Must have reached the age of 16
Adult SYS Class I - Must have reached the age of 18
Adult SYS Class II - Must have reached the age of 18
Adult SYS Class III - Must have reached the age of 18

Adult Skating Categories for Freeskate and Artistic – Skaters Age as of July 1, 2024

Young Adult – 18 to 24 years of age
Class I – 25 to 35 years of age
Class II - 36 to 45 years of age
Class III – 46 to 55 years of age
Class IV – 56 years of age and older
Class 5 – 68 years of age and older

Sectionals Qualifying Technical Element Scores

Sectionals & Star Pathway Crossover Eligibility Chart

For skaters registered for the 2025 Skate AB I NT I NU Sectional Championships (event takes place October 31 – November 3, 2024), the crossover eligibility chart illustrates the categories a skater is permitted to register for at the 2025 Skate AB I NT I NU StarSkate & Adult Championships and the Star Series #1-4 & Star Territorials for the 2024-2025 Season.

For skaters registering for the Sectional Championships, the Crossover Eligibility Chart details which categories they may and may not enter for the Star Series #1-4/Star Territorials competitions and the StarSkate Championships.

StarSkate Championships Qualifying Process and Zones

The StarSkate Championships Qualifying Process and Competition Zones are provided on the Section website on the Competition Information Page. This structure is annually reviewed by the Section's Competition Committee.

The Qualifying Structure outlines the Star qualifying categories, the number of competitions in which a skater may register for and how to obtain and track their scores.

The Competition Zones provides a skater with the first opportunity to register for the Star Series competition which is being held within their home zone.

Age Requirements/Registration Details/Skating Up

1. **Proof of Age:** may be required to register for events with age restrictions. Competitors in age restricted categories may be required to show proof of age at a competition and should have proof of age with them at each competition.
2. Any skater entered in an age-restricted category, for which they are not qualified, shall be disqualified. The skater will not be permitted to change categories after the designated change cut-off date as indicated in the announcement. Entry fees shall not be refunded after the registration deadline.
3. Registration deadlines, entry fees and registration change fees are detailed in each competition announcement.
4. **Skating Up:** skating up one level is permitted; however, skaters are permitted to enter only one level per

category at a competition. Skaters may only enter one short program and freeskate program. For example: a skater may enter a Juvenile Freeskate and a Star 7 Short program at the same competition. However, as an example, a skater may not enter a Juvenile Freeskate and Star 6 freeskate program or a Star 5 freeskate and a Star 6 freeskate within the same competition.

Planned Program(s) Submission Requirements

Planned Programs detail the list of elements which a skater performs in each program. The planned programs are provided to the officials at the competition, and it is a benefit to the skater that the planned programs for each program are submitted.

Planned programs must be submitted online through the skater's Uplifter account. Deadline dates are provided for each competition announcement.

Planned Programs are required to be submitted for the following categories:

Star Pathway:

- Star 5 - Gold Short and Freeskates
- Star 5 – Gold Artistics

Podium Pathway:

- Singles - Short and Freeskates
- Dance – Rhythm Dances and Free Dances
- Pairs – Short and Freeskates

Adult:

- Freeskates

Special Olympics:

- Freeskates

Synchronized Skating:

- Star 4 – Gold
- Open, Novice, Junior Senior, Senior Elite 12
- Adult Sys Class I, II, III

Warm-Up Times

Freestyle Assessments at Competitions

Skaters may apply to take Star 6 – Gold Freestyle program assessment in competition where it is offered by the organizing committee. Assessments will depend on availability of a qualified evaluator and will be granted on an application basis. The following chart indicates the applicable competition categories that a skater may attempt a Star Program assessment during competition. Skaters must enter the appropriate competition category for assessment.
