MUSIC REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

Online Music Registration

New this season – only USBs are being accepted as back up music. (no CD's)

- a. Music registration will be specified in each competition as it may apply.
- b. Music is to be uploaded through the skater's Uplifter account.
- c. Online music registration will require each skater or team to submit an mp3 file of their program music at the time of their registration. This includes music for pattern dances.
- d. Music files will not be kept so skaters and teams will be required to submit their music for each individual competition.
- e. Backup Music: each skater or team will be required to carry a copy of their music USB and have it available at rink-side as a backup. Cell phones, iPods, and other personal devices will not be accepted.
- f. If there have been changes to the music after the submission during the online registration, the updated music file must be uploaded by the deadline date specified in each respective competition announcement.

Music Registration – submitted at competition registration (not online)

For competitions that do not require online music registration, each skater or team will be required to provide one (1) USB copy of each of their programs for which they are competing to the registration desk at the competition. Skaters will not be permitted to register onsite if their music is not provided.

Backup Music: each skater or team will be required to carry a copy of their music USB and have it available at rink-side as a backup. Cell phones, iPods, and other personal devices will not be accepted.

Skaters are to carry a copy of their music as backup on USB.

How to Label Skater's USBs

Skaters or team's must clearly label their USB by placing the USB in a Ziploc Bag and labelling the bag with a permanent marker/pen with the following details clearly printed: first and last name(s), category name and home club.

Music Recording Specifications

- a. The only format for online upload of music is mp3.
- b. When providing a USB, ensure only the current skating programs for the competition you are entering are downloaded onto the USB. Each program must be clearly specified on the USB Ziploc bag. For example: John Doe, Pre-Novice Short or Jane Smith, Star 6

All music used must be in the public domain or covered by the performing rights societies. Competitors who have music composed specifically for their programs either wholly or in part, are responsible for obtaining a written release from the composer for the use of such music on radio and/or television or appropriate clearance from the performing rights societies.
