



## **2024-2025 Junior Development Team Criteria**

Skaters will qualify for the 2024-2025 Skate AB|NT|NU Section Junior Development Team based on their placement at the 2024-2025 Sectional Championship, as outlined below:

### **Singles:**

Juvenile U10 Women:	Top 8 skaters
Juvenile U12 Women:	Top 10 skaters
Juvenile U10 Men:	Top 8 skaters
Juvenile U12 Men:	Top 6 skaters
Juvenile U14 Women:	Top 4 skaters
Juvenile U14 Men:	Top 4 skaters
Pre-Novice Women:	Top 3 skaters <u>not</u> qualifying for Challenge (Placement 6-8)
Pre-Novice Men:	Top 3 skaters <u>not</u> qualifying for Challenge (Placement 6-8)

### **Ice Dance:**

Pre-Juvenile:	Top 4 teams
Juvenile:	Top 4 teams
Pre-Novice:	Top 3 teams <u>not</u> qualifying for Challenge

### **Pairs:**

Juvenile:	Top 4 teams
Pre-Novice:	Top 3 teams <u>not</u> qualifying for Challenge

Additionally, skaters may qualify for the Junior Development Team through wild card placements, as outlined below:

### **Wild Cards - Juvenile U10, U12, U14 Women and Men:**

- Any skater who achieves a bonus while competing at the Sectional Championship will automatically qualify for the Junior Development Team.

### **Wild Cards - Pre-Novice Women and Men:**

- Skaters who achieve any bonus, in either the short or the free program, while competing at the Sectional Championship will automatically qualify for the Junior Development Team.
- After the top 3 placements not qualifying for Challenge, AND after any skaters added because of the bonuses, then the next 5 skaters who achieve a combined score greater than 65 points (women) or 50 points (men) while competing at the Sectional Championship AND are U13 as of July 1, 2024, will automatically qualify for the Junior Development Team.
