Entries: Entrants in Events shall be:

a) Eligible persons as defined in Skate Canada Rule Book Section 2100

b) Be Associate members in good standing of the Association. All event entries will beaccepted only from skaters who are members of affiliated Skate Canada clubs.

*Registration forms **MUST BE COMPLETED IN FULL** or they may not be processed!

<u>CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES</u>: All entries must be registered online no later than **December 31**, **2024**. It is the responsibility of the skater to ensure that their entry is in tothe Host Committee Registration person by the closing date.

LATE ENTRIES: There will be absolutely no late entries accepted after thedeadline. No exceptions.

REFUND OF ENTRY FEES: Entry fees shall be refunded *only* if the event is not held. There will be no refunds given for any reason, including medical pulls. No exceptions.

REGISTRATION ON DAY OF EVENT: Skaters must register at least one hour prior to their scheduled Categoryor practice. Skaters must report to the Ice Captain one hour prior to their scheduled Category.

SCHEDULE AND CANCELLATION OF EVENTS: The host club reserves the right to cancel events or limit the number of entries due to time constraints or ice availability. Schedule will be posted on our website <u>www.stettlerskatingclub.com</u> and sent out via email.

CANSKATE ELEMENTS EVENT

Elements are to be skated as elements in isolation.

*Note that skills are integrated, if a skater has passed Stage 1 they would enter in Stage 2.

Stage 1:

Forward push/glide sequence Two-foot jump on a spot Backward two-foot skating/walking

Stage 2:

Forward to Backward 2 foot turn Backward to Forward two-foot turn Backward two-foot to one foot glide Forward two-foot sculling

Stage 3:

Forward circle thrusts Backward two-foot jump Backwards two-foot sculling

Stage 4:

Forward Crosscuts Backward Circle Thrusts Forward 1 foot turn Forward to backward 2 foot jump Backward to forward 2 foot jump

Stage 5:

Forward Inside Edges Forward 2 foot side stop Backward push glide sequence Forward power jump

Stage 6:

Forward Outside Edges Forward 1 foot side stop Backward perimeter skating with crosscuts Forward to backward C Step

CANSKATE SPIN, SPIRAL, JUMP CANSKATE STAGE 5/6

This is a one-minute program to be skated on 1/2 of the ice surface. A beginning and ending pose as well as connecting steps may be included. *MUSIC PROVIDED BY HOST CLUB

- Skaters must be working on CanSkate Stage 5 or 6
- Must include: One forward upright spin (2 foot or 1 foot)
- Waltz jump OR Toe loop
- One spiral (skater's choice of foot)

SPIN, SPIRAL, JUMP EVENT STAR 1 LEVEL

This is a one-minute and 30-second program to be skated on the full ice surface. Program must include ONLY 1 spin, 1 spiral sequence, and 3 jumps. A beginning and ending pose as well as connecting steps should be included. *MUSIC PROVIDED BY HOST CLUB

- Skaters must be working on STAR 1 FreeSkate
- Must include: One forward OR backward upright spin
- Waltz jump, toe loop, and salchow
- One spiral sequence consisting of one forward spiral done on each foot on either inside or outside edges

STAR 2 & 3 Elements:

Walts + Toe Loop Loop Backward Upright Spin Forward Spiral Sequence

Star 3 Elements:

Flip Loop + Loop Combo Combo Spin Forward Spiral Sequence
