3. Closing Date of Entries: All entries must be received by Monday, January 6th, 2025

4. ACCIDENTS:

The Association and Committee of the Host Club undertake no responsibility for damages or injuries suffered by the skater. As a condition of and in consideration of their entries in these Events, all skaters and their parents or guardians shall agree to assume all risks or injuries to the competitor's person and property resulting from, or caused by, or connected with the conduct and management of the events. An agreement must also be deemed to release any and all claims they may have against the officials, the Association, the Host Club, and their officers. Entries shall be accepted only in accordance with these conditions.

- **5. REFUND OF ENTRY FEES:** Entry fees shall be refunded only if the event is not held or if the entry is withdrawn before the date of close of entries (Skate Canada Rule 7000-1.5(2)).
- **6. CANCELLATION OF EVENTS:** The host club reserves the right to cancel events. The Lloydminster Skating Club reserves the right to limit the number of registrations due to time.
- **7. AWARDS:** It is the responsibility of ALL skaters receiving a medal to wear their skates and skating attire for the medal presentation. Awards will be approximately 30 minutes following each event. Everyone goes home a winner!
- **8. PICTURES & VIDEOS:** Persons wishing to take photographs of on ice performances are reminded that use of flash cameras is forbidden. The use of video cameras must be restricted to areas that do not hamper the skaters. NOTE: You may only take pictures or videos of your own skater. No parents will be allowed in the player's box area.

CanSkate Category Specifications CanSkate Elements

Results are tabulated for each individual separately. Skaters do not compete against each other for a ranking since awards are based on performance standards alone.

Elements will be done in circuits from stages 1-4 and one at a time (in isolation) for stages 5-6.

Note: Skills are integrated; if a skater has passed Stage 1 they would enter Stage 2. The participants execute elements according to their categories.

Four elements are performed in each category. The required elements are defined as follows:

Pre-CanSkate Elements:

- Fall down & get up
- forward steps
- make snow
- jump on the spot

Stage 1 Elements:

- Forward push/glide sequence
- Forward 2-ft jump
- Backward 2-ft skating/walking

Stage 2 Elements:

- Forward 2-ft sculling
- Forward 2-ft turn
- Backward 2-ft to 1-ft glide

Stage 3 Elements:

- Forward circle thrusts
- Backward 2-ft sculling
- Backward 2-ft jump

Stage 4 Elements:

- Forward 1-ft turn
- Forward crosscut
- Backward circle thrusts or pump
- 2-ft jump forward to backwards and backwards to forwards

Stage 5 Elements:

- Forward inside edges
- Forward 2-ft side stop
- Backward push glide sequence
- Forward power jump

Stage 6 Elements:

- Forward 1-ft side stop
- Backward perimeter skating with crosscuts
- Forward/backward and backward/forward C steps
- Forward outside edges

Stage 5 /6 Spin Spiral Jump:

-This is a one minute program to be skated on ½ of the ice surface.

Program must include

- -ONLY 1 forward upright spin,
- -ONLY 1 spiral (skater's choice) and
- -ONLY 1 jump (waltz jump or toe loop)

These elements can be in any order. A beginning and

ending pose as well as connecting steps may be included. Skaters must be working on Stage 5 and 6. No music.

Stage 5 /6 Creative Improv:

- Skaters will hear a selected piece of music twice in warm up.

They will perform a creative routine on the ice to the music selection. Program length should not exceed 1 minute. Skaters must be working on Stage 5 or 6.

CanSkate Team Event:

Teams can be made up of 2-4 team members. Each member will perform one (or two) element in isolation.

CanSkate Team A (Stage 1/2)

- -snow slide steps
- -forward 2ft jump
- -forward 2ft sculling
- -2ft glide

CanSkate Team B (Stage 3 /4)

- -forward circle thrusts
- -backward 2ft sculling
- -backward circle thrusts
- -forward inside slalom

CanSkate Team C (Stage 5 /6)

- -two-foot side stop
- -forward figure 8 crosscuts
- -forward 1ft side stop
- -forward outside edges

Star 1 Elements:

-Stroking Exercise -Forward Upright Spin -Waltz Jump -Backward Upright Spin

-Salchow -Spiral Circle

-Toe Loop -Creative Expression Routine

Star 2 Elements:

- -Waltz and Toe Loop Combo Jump
- -Loop Jump
- -Backward Upright Spin
- -Forward Spiral Sequence

Star 3 Elements:

- -Flip Jump
- -Loop-Loop Combo Jump
- -Combo Spin
- -Forward Spiral Sequence

Star 2-3 Freeskate

Skaters must have passed Stage 6 CanSkate but not have passed Star level 3. Will be performed on full ice. Music can be brought that day on a smart device. Please supply the applicable cord

Star 2 Freeskate Program Event:

(please bring music on smart device and supply applicable cord)

Skaters will perform their trained Star 2 Program with their music and be assessed on the following criteria:

-Waltz and Toe Loop Combo Jump -Backward Upright Spin Spins in the Program

-Toe Loop -Sit Spin or Camel Spin -Spiral Sequence -3 Turn Sequence

-Loop Jump Skating Skills -Forward Spiral Sequence

-Flip or Lutz Jump -Presentation and Skating Skills

Star 3 Freeskate Program Event:

(please bring music on smart device and supply applicable cord)

Skaters will perform their trained Star 3 Program with their music and be assessed on the following criteria:

Jumps in the Program
Spins in the Program
Spiral Sequence
Skating Skills
Presentation
Interpretation

Star 1-3 Creative Improv

Skaters must have passed Stage 6 Canskate.

Skaters will listen to a 45 second piece of music twice, off ice, in a designated area. They will hear the music one more time during the on ice warm up. They will wait in the dressing room until it is their turn to perform. No coaching will be permitted during this event.

Star 1-3 Team Events:

Each team will consist of 2-4 team members. Each member will perform 1-2 elements in isolation.

- -Waltz and Toe Loop Combo Jump
- -Loop Jump

- -Flip Jump
- -Loop-Loop Combo Jump
- -Combo Spin
- -Spiral Sequence
