- If you have not previously registered for programming at the Peace River Skating Club, you will be required to create an account as the parent and add your skater(s) as the participant. You will need your skater(s) Skate Canada Number.

REGISTRATION CHECK-IN: Skaters and coaches will need to check in one hour prior to their event. Registration table will open one hour prior to the first event.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The Event is being held following the CanSkate Element Technical Package and Star Event Standards for Assessment Guide.
2. **Categories:** The following Categories are to be held:
 - Star 1 Freeskate (half ice)- All elements, stroking exercise and creative
 - Star 2 Elements
 - Star 2 Freeskate Program
 - Star 2 Team Elements
 - Star 3 Elements
 - Star 3 Freeskate Program
 - Star 3 Team Elements

All Star categories must follow the SKATE CANADA 2023-2024 technical requirements; inclusive of the well-balanced program criteria as posted on the Skate Canada Members Info Centre at **Competition Program Requirements** - STAR (skatecanada.ca)

3. **Number of Entries:** Number of entries will be limited to 100.
4. **System of Marking:** The event is following the STAR Event Standards for Assessment Guide.
5. **Entry Fees:** \$75.00 per event and paid with credit card at time of online registration.
6. **Closing Date of Entries:** All entries must be received NO LATER than January 31st, 2025, at 12:00pm (noon) MT.

- 7. Refund of Entry Fees:** Entry fees shall be refunded only if the event is not held or if the entry is withdrawn before the date of close of entries. There will be a \$10.00 administration fee applied to all withdrawal refunds. After the closing date of entries there will be no refunds given for any reason, including medical pulls. No exceptions.
- 8. Music Submission Requirements:**
- Each skater will be required to submit their music online **at time of registration**. Music must be in an MP3 format and saved as Last Name, First Name-Category (example Bird, Blue-Star 2)
 - Each skater is required to carry a USB memory stick with their music on it and have it available at rink-side as a back-up. Cell phones, iPads, and other personal devices will not be accepted.
- 9. Schedule of Events:** Will be emailed to all registered skaters.
- 10. Warm-Up Times:**
Star 1-Star 2: 3 minutes
Star 3: 4 minutes
- 11. Accidents:** The Association and Committee of the Host Club undertake no responsibility for damages or injuries suffered by the skater. As a condition of and in consideration of their entries in this competition, all competitors and their parents or guardians shall be deemed to agree to assume all risks or injuries to the competitor's person and property resulting from, or caused by, or connected with the conduct and management of the competitions. An agreement must also be deemed to release any and all claims they may have against the officials, the Association, the Host Club, and their officers. Entries shall be accepted only in accordance with these conditions.
- 12. Cancellation of Events:** The host club reserves the right to cancel events.
- 13. Coach Accreditation:** All coaches must be minimally certified NCCP Regional in-training and Coaches must register at the registration desk. Coaches must be in good standing with Skate Canada.
- 14. Awards:** Awards will be held upstairs on the hour and half hour.
- 15. Pictures and Videos:** Persons wishing to take photographs of on ice performances are reminded that use of flash cameras is forbidden. NOTE: You may only take pictures or videos of your own skater and must be taken from the spectator seating areas, to not hamper the progress of the competition.
