<u>Note:</u> Planned program content sheets deadline: Dec. 4, 2024 at 12:00 pm noon MT. To be submitted on Skate Alberta website. (Only needs to be submitted once during the year, changes that need to be made can be done on the invoice in the member's account)

- 1. Maximum two coaches and one alternate may stand at the ON Ice gate with the Ice Level Referee. A second coach (if not at the ON gate), team manager and other alternates must be in the exit area/Kiss & Cry. Chaperones are not permitted; they are allowed in the dressing room only.
- 2. **Map of Max Bell is attached with dressing rooms, off and on gates, warm up areas. Please note, the warm up areas have changed from last year. Warm up 1 and 2 are in the yoga studio. Warm up 3 and 4 are on the 2nd floor lobby (it is a public shared space).
- 3. Music

Music was submitted with registration.

Each team will be required to carry a copy of their music on USB memory stick and have it available at rink side as backup in a clear bag with team name and category on it. A memory stick may contain all the programs the team is competing in for the competition, however, the programs on the memory stick must be properly digitally labelled to ensure the correct music is played. For example: Team A, Novice Short Program. Each USB must contain music for only one team.

4. Off Ice Warm Up

Warm up areas 1 and 2 are in the yoga studio. Warm up areas 3 and 4 are on the 2nd floor lobby (it is a public shared space).

5. Results

Report cards and protocols will be available at the competition and posted on the Skate Canada AB/NWT/Nunavut website.

6. Awards and Medal Presentations

Two skaters and one coach may represent each team. Medals and awards will be presented on ice at the end of the competition for Juvenile and above. The Star award presentation (Star 4 synchro and Star Team Elements) will be done off ice at 1:56 pm. It is up to skaters/teams whether they remain in their competition dress or wear team off-ice clothing. An area to put skates on will be designated.

7. Report Card Feedback

In person feedback will be provided to teams in qualifying categories at the conclusion of the competition in the Officials' room, according to the follow draft schedule. **Team Managers or Coaches need to confirm their intent to take part with the Technical Representative via email or text (mayerholly@hotmail.com or 587-583-3936) prior to the day of the competition.**

All other teams can submit questions via email to the Tech Rep, or the appropriate Referee and Technical Controller. Please submit specific questions, rather than a request for general feedback.

8. First Aid Volunteer

Located rink side in the "home" players box. If there is a medical emergency, call 911. First Aid Volunteer has the Emergency Action Plan for the Max Bell Centre.

9. Parking

Buses may drop off skaters/coaches at the front entrance and then drive to the side of the building to park. There is no charge for parking at this facility.
