#### 2. CATEGORIES

#### 3. Registration

#### 4. Closing Date of Entries

All entries must be received **NO LATER** than Thursday, December 12 11:59 PM (noon) MST. It is the responsibility of the competitor to ensure that their entry is submitted by the closing date.

#### 5. Entry Fee: To be paid in Uplifter.

#### 6. Event Schedule

Will be posted on the Yellowknife Skating Club's Facebook page and emailed to skaters.

#### 7. Refund of Entry Fees

Entry fees shall be refunded only if the event is not held. There will be no refunds given for any reason, including medical pulls.

#### 8. Music

Coaches need to email or airdrop their music to the Yellowknife Skating club as an MP3. Skaters must have an USB stick with their program as backup. Skaters are responsible for the recovery of their own music at the completion of the event.

#### 9. On-Site Registration

Skaters must register a minimum of one hour prior to the start of their scheduled event. Skaters must report to the Ice Captain one hour prior to their scheduled event.

#### 10. Marking System

CanSkate ELEMENT EVENT categories will be assessed in accordance with the CanSkate Element Event Technical Package

Star 1-3 will be judged as per the Star Standards for Assessment Guide

#### 11. Awards / Presentations

These will be held after every event. It is the responsibility of the skaters to wear their skates & skating attire for the presentations. Please remember to bring your skate guards.

#### 12. Event Specifications

CanSkate categories will combine boys and girls by stage and age. In normal circumstances, Star 1-3 categories offered at competitions will be combined. The decision to combine categories is at the discretion of the Competition Chair with the input of the host committee.

#### 13. Warm Up Times

Skate Canada has standardized warm up times for all events.

#### 14. Accidents

The Association and Committee of the Host Club undertake no responsibility for damages or injuries suffered by the skater. As a condition of and in consideration of their entries in this event, all competitors and their parents or guardians shall be deemed to release any and all claims they may have against the Officials, the Association, the Host Club and their officers. Entries shall be only in accordance with these conditions.

#### 15. Pictures & Video

Persons wishing to take photographs of on ice performances are reminded that the use of flash cameras is NOT permitted. The use of video cameras must be restricted to areas that do not hamper the skater or officials. NOTE: You may ONLY take photos or videos of your own skater.

## CANSKATE ELEMENTS EVENT

Elements are to be skated as elements in isolation. \*Note that skills are integrated, if a skater has passed Stage 1 they would enter in Stage 2.

#### Stage 1:

- Forward push/glide sequence
- Two-foot jump on a spot
- Backward two-foot skating/walking

#### Stage 2:

- Forward to Backward 2 foot turn
- Backward to Forward two-foot turn
- Backward two-foot to one foot glide
- Forward two-foot sculling

#### Stage 3:

- Forward circle thrusts
- Backward two-foot jump
- Backwards two-foot sculling

#### Stage 4:

- Forward Crosscuts
- Backward Circle Thrusts
- Forward 1 foot turn
- Forward to backward 2 foot jump
- Backward to forward 2 foot jump

#### Stage 5:

- Forward Inside Edges
- Forward 2 foot side stop
- Backward push glide sequence
- Forward power jump

#### Stage 6:

- Forward Outside Edges
- Forward 1 foot side stop
- Backward perimeter skating with crosscuts
- Forward to backward C Step

## CANSKATE SPIN, SPIRAL, JUMP CANSKATE STAGE 5/6

This is a one-minute program to be skated on 1/2 of the ice surface. A beginning and ending pose as well as connecting steps may be included.

- Skaters must be working on CanSkate Stage 5 or 6
- Must include: One forward upright spin (2 foot or 1 foot)
- Waltz jump OR Toe loop
- One spiral (skater's choice of foot)

## SPIN, SPIRAL, JUMP SHOWCASE EVENT STAR 1 LEVEL

This is a one-minute and 30-second program to be skated on the full ice surface. Program must include ONLY 1 spin, 1 spiral sequence, and 3 jumps. A beginning and ending pose as well as connecting steps should be included. Program will be evaluating ONLY Presentation and Skating Skills.

- Skaters must be working on STAR 1 FreeSkate
- Must include: One forward OR backward upright spin
- Waltz jump, toe loop, and salchow
- One spiral sequence consisting of one forward spiral done on each foot on either inside or outside edges

## STAR 2 & 3 Freeskate/Elements Criteria:
