Volunteer Opportunity Peace Region Coaching Representative

Skate AB | NT | NU (Section) is currently looking for a Peace Region Coaching Representative.

The position of Peace Region Coaching Representative was not filled during the 2024 election process and is now considered a casual vacancy. The position may be filled by appointment by the Section Board of Directors to complete the two-year term for 2024-2026.

The Region Coaching Representative is a member of the Peace Region Committee and a member of the Section Coaching Committee.

Region Coaching Representative Description

The Region Coaching Representative represents the perspectives of member coaches of the Region to the Section Coaching Committee and the Local Region Committee. Roles of the Region Coaching Representative include:

- Representing the perspective of Skate Canada member coaches residing and coaching in the Region to the Section Coaching Committee and the Local Region Committee.
- Supporting, liaising, and sharing information with member coaches within the Region;
- Providing support as required to member coaches and/or other Skate Canada members in the Region on coaching matters.
- Liaising with the other Region Coaching Representatives and the Section Coaching Committee Lead.
- Attending the NW Region meetings and providing a Coaches Report for these meetings.
- Attending and participating in the Section Coaching Committee Meetings held 3-4 times per year.
