
- 1. **Categories**: The following categories are to be held:

2. Entry Fees:


- a. CanSkate 1-6 \$45

- 3. Event Schedule: The schedule will be posted and sent to all participants once finalized.
- 4. **Entries**: Must be registrants of Skate Canada and in Good Standing.
- 5. Closing Date of Entries: All entries must be registered online no later than midnight on *December 22nd*, 2024. It is the responsibility of the skater to ensure their entry is in to the Host Committee Registration person by the closing date. *Spaces will be limited so please ensure to register early to avoid disappointment.*
- 6. **Late Entries:** Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Host Committee and if space permits.
- 7. **Refund of Entry Fees:** *No refunds will be made after the closing date.* Entry fees shall be refunded only if the event is not held.
- 8. **On-Site Registration:** Skaters must register at least 1 hour prior to their scheduled category. Skaters must report to the Ice Captain 30 minutes prior to their scheduled category. All music will be played digitally by iPod or MP3 player and must be submitted at time of registration.
- 9. **Schedule and Cancellation of Events:** The host club reserves the right to cancel events or limit the number of entries due to time constraints or ice availability. **Spaces will be limited so please ensure to register early to avoid disappointment.**
- 10. Warm-Up Times: Skate Canada has standardized warm-up times for all events
- 11. **Awards**: Medals and award sheets will be presented on-site at the event.




CHALLENGE: STAGE 2 ASSESSMENT




CHALLENGE: STAGE 3 ASSESSMENT




CHALLENGE: STAGE 4 ASSESSMENT

STARSKATE FREESKATE EVENTS

STAR 1 ELEMENTS

Skaters will perform the following skills and will be assessed accordingly. Coaches may be on the ice with their skaters to build confidence and sureness in their performance.

- Circle Stroking
- Waltz Jump
- Salchow
- Toe Loop
- Forward Upright Spin
- Backward Upright Spin
- Forward Spiral Circles
- Creative Expression Routine

STAR 1 CREATIVE IMPROV

Skaters will hear a piece of music selected by the host club twice prior to warm-up. They will hear the music once more during their warm up. They will perform a creative routine on the ice to the music selection. Music will be 45 seconds.

STAR 2 FREESKATE PROGRAM

Skaters will perform their trained STAR 2 Program to their music and will be assessed based on the Skate Canada criteria for Star 2 Freeskate programs. Program music to be submitted at the time of registration.

STAR 3 FREESKATE PROGRAM

Skaters will perform their trained STAR 3 Program to their music and will be assessed based on the Skate Canada criteria for Star 3 Freeskate programs. Program music to be submitted at the time of registration.

STARSKATE TEAM EVENTS

Team Events are an opportunity for groups of up to four skaters to perform together in a fun atmosphere. Skaters will each perform one Freeskate element and will contribute to an overall team assessment. Elements will be performed in the order listed.

STAR 2 TEAM ELEMENTS: (STAR 1 skaters can also register here. Indicate at the time of registration if they are all STAR 1 skaters, all STAR 2 skaters, or a mix of STAR 1 and 2 skaters)

- Waltz + Toe Loop
- Loop Jump
- Backward Upright Spin
- Forward Spiral Sequence

STAR 3 TEAM ELEMENTS:

- Flip jump
- Loop/loop Combination
- Combination Spin
- Forward Spiral Sequence
