- b. Be Associate members in good standing of the Association. Registration forms must be completed in FULL, or they may not be processed.

4. ENTRY FEES

Cheques post dated after the close of entries will be returned and registration will not be processed. There will be a \$40.00 charge for any NSF cheques received.

5. CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES

All entries must be received by no later than April 4, 2025. Skating times will be emailed to the club contact indicated on the entry form. (1 contact person per club please). Skater may skate up a level.

6. ACCIDENTS:

The Association and Committee of the Host Club undertake no responsibility for damages or injuries suffered by the skater. As a condition of and in consideration of their entries in these Events, all skaters and their parents or guardians shall be deemed to agree to assume all risks or injuries to the competitor's person and property resulting from, or caused by, or connected with

the conduct and management of the events. An agreement must also be deemed to release any. and all claims they may have against the officials, the Association, the Host Club, and their officers. Entries shall be accepted only in accordance with these conditions.

7. REFUND OF ENTRY FEES:

Entry fees shall be refunded only if the event is not held or if the entry is withdrawn before the date of close of entries (Skate Canada Rule 7000-1.5(2)).

8. REGISTRATION

- Skaters must be in their assigned dressing rooms 30 minutes before their event.
- Please check in at the registration desk a minimum of 1 hour prior to the start of your event.
- Each event will warm up on the half of the ice surface on which they will be evaluated and then clear the ice until it is their turn to perform.

(Warm up time is 3 minutes for Star 1 & 2 and 4 minutes for Star 3).

• Star 1-3 Freeskate will be on full ice. The Fun Meet will take place between the hours of 8:00 am – 6:00 pm.

9. CANCELLATIONS OF EVENTS

The host club reserves the right to cancel events. The Cold Lake Figure Skating Club reserves the right to limit the number of registrations due to time.

10. AWARDS

Awards will be ongoing all day long and will be available approximately 30 minutes following each event and a podium will be available for photographs. Everyone goes home a winner!

11. PICTURES & VIDEOS

Persons wishing to take photographs of on ice performances are reminded that flash photography is forbidden. The use of video cameras must be restricted to areas that do not hamper the skaters. <u>NOTE:</u> You may only take pictures or videos of your own skater. No parents will be allowed in the player's box area.

CanSkate Categories – Technical Information

Each skater will complete each of his/her elements before the next skater begins. Elements will be done in circuits from stages 1 - 4 and one at a time (not in a routine) for stages 5 - 6. NOTE: Skills are integrated; if a skater has passed Stage 1 they would enter Stage 2

Stage 2:

Stage 3: o Forward circle thrusts o Backward 2-foot sculling o Backward 2-foot jump

Stage 4: o Forward crosscuts o Backward circle pumps/thrusts o Forward 1-foot turn (both feet) o Fwd/Bwd and Bwd/Fwd 2-foot jump Stage 6: o Forward outside edges

- o Forward 1-foot side stop (both feet)
- o Backward perimeter skating with crosscuts
- o Fwd/Bwd and Bwd/Fwd c-steps

SPIN SPIRAL JUMP REQUIREMENTS

This is a one-minute program to be skated on 1/2 of the ice surface. Program must include ONLY 1 spin, ONLY 1 spiral and ONLY 1 jump (in any order). A beginning and ending pose as well as

connecting steps may be included. NO MUSIC.

Skaters must be working on CanSkate Stage 5 or 6. Must include: Any forward upright spin. Waltz jump or Toe loop One foot spiral (skater's choice)

STAGE 5/6 CREATIVE IMPROV 1

Skaters will hear a piece of music selected by the host club twice in warm-up. They will perform a creative routine on the ice to the music selection. Program length is 45 seconds. Skaters must have passed Stage 5 CanSkate. Skaters will be categorized by age and level.

CANSKATE TEAM ELEMENT EVENT

Each team will consist of 2 to 4 skaters. Skaters will complete skills together from his/her team stage. Skills will be chosen from the above stages. Skills will be done together by each team. Coaches may assist their skaters, as there will not be use of circuits for this event. Skaters may skate up a stage.

Stage 1/2: o Snow slide steps o Forward 2-foot jump o Forward 2-foot sculling o Fwd 2 Foot Glide Stage 3/4: o Forward circle thrusts o Backward 2-foot sculling o Backward circle thrusts o Forward 1-foot turn (both feet)

Stage 5/6: o Forward 2-foot side stop (both directions) o Backward push/glide sequence o Forward 1-foot side stop (both feet) o Forward outside edges

Star 1 – 3 Event Categories – Technical Information

Star 1-3 Event Categories for Elements - Technical Information. Star 1-3 Element Events -Individual element event. Each skater will perform each element in isolation and skaters will take turns within their group. Skaters must have passed Stage 6 CanSkate but must not have passed Star Level 3.

Star 2-3 Event Categories for Freeskate

Skaters must have passed Stage 6 CanSkate but must not have passed Star Level 3.

Skaters will perform their trained Star 2 Program with their music and be assessed on the following criteria:

Star 1-3 Event Categories for Team

Each team will consist of two to four members. Each member will perform one element in isolation. Skaters who have not passed any Star 5 Freeksate.

Star 1-3 Event Categories for Creative Improv 2

Skaters will hear a piece of music 45 seconds long selected by the host club twice in warm-up. They will perform a creative routine on the ice to the music selection.
