

2025 StarSkate and Adult Championships EVENT INFORMATION

Dear Skaters and Coaches,

We are looking forward to seeing you at the 2025 Skate AB I NT I NU StarSkate and Adult Championships. This letter provides you with specific details about the event. Please read the entire letter carefully.

Facility

Seven Chiefs Sportsplex 19 Bullhead Rd Tsuut'ina, AB (Calgary)

Parking: Parking at the facility is free.

Spectators: Spectators are welcome. There is no fee to watch the event.

Event Reminders

- Event page website link for all event details: Event Page
- **Registration Desk:** The registration desk will be open one hour before the start of the first category each day.
- Warm-up Area: The designated warm-up area is on the indoor track on the upper level. To access the track, go up the stairs from the main lobby, go to the right and go up another set of stairs. There will be signage to guide you to the track. There are other user groups who will be using the track at the same time. Skaters are also permitted to warm up on the main floor in front of arena 2, just past the vendors as well as on the second floor in the open foyer area, and on the upper concourse areas in each arena.
- Back up Music USB: Skaters' must bring their back-up USBs to the ice with them USBs are not being collected at the registration table. Please ensure your USB is placed in a Ziploc bag, with the bag properly labelled with skater name and category.
- Schedule: The schedule is posted on the event page of the Skate AB I NT I NU website.
- Start Order/Results/Skater Details: The start orders are now posted on the website. Skater details and results will also be posted on the website.
- Withdrawal Form: The online form must be used to submit any withdrawals from the event. The form is posted on the event page of the Skate AB I NT I NU website.
- **Protest/Clarification Form:** The online form must be used to submit any protests/clarifications. The form is posted on the event page of the Skate AB I NT I NU website.
- Medal Presentations: Medals will be presented at the event for each category. Skaters that are the sole entry in their category will also receive a medal. A medal presentation schedule will be posted near the medal presentation area. Skaters are required to wear their skates and skating attire for the medal presentations.

- Leading Edge Series Medal Presentations: The final standings for the Star Leading Edge Series will be posted in the dressing room hallway at the event after each Leading Edge Series category. These medals will be presented at the same time as the event medals.
- Live Stream: Both arenas will be live streamed. The links are provided on the event page of the Skate AB I NT I NU website.
- **Purchase Your Skaters Video:** You may purchase your skater's performance by submitting the online form available on the event page of the Skate AB I NT I NU website by March 26.
- 2025 StarSkate and Adult Merit Award: The Alberta Figure Skating Foundation is proud to support the Merit Award. The Merit Award is selected amongst the Officials at the event to recognize a memorable or outstanding performance (singles, pair, and dance). The Alberta Figure Skating Foundation awards a \$250 bursary to the recipient. The recipient may be announced at the final medal presentation of the event on Sunday afternoon.

COACH Specific Information

- If your skater ends up handing in their back-up USB on the ice, the USB will be placed at the registration desk and the skater or an assigned coach from the skaters' club may pick up the USB.
- **Coach Hospitality Room:** Dressing room 1F located in Arena 2 is available for coaches' hospitality. Coffee, tea, and a small assortment of snacks will be provided (fruit, assorted granola bars.) There is NO fee.
- **Coach ID tags:** Coaches must comply by their certification levels to be rink-side. Coaches MUST check in at the registration desk and collect their ID tag. Coaches must pre-purchase their accreditation tag for the season. The Coach Accreditation Tag Purchase form is on the event page of the Skate AB I NT I NU website.
- Reminder: a maximum of two (2) coaches per skater or team is permitted by the boards.
