



2025-2026 Skate AB | NT | NU Development Team* Criteria

Skaters will qualify for the 2025-2026 Skate AB | NT | NU Development Team based on their placement at the 2025-2026 Sectional Championship, as outlined below:

Singles:

Pre–Juvenile U11 Women:	Top 8 skaters
Pre–Juvenile U11 Men:	Top 8 skaters
Juvenile U12 Women:	Top 8 skaters
Juvenile U12 Men:	Top 8 skaters
Juvenile U14 Women:	Top 4 skaters
Juvenile U14 Men:	Top 4 skaters
Pre-Novice Women:	Top 3 skaters <u>not</u> qualifying for Skate Canada Trophy (Placement 6-8)
Pre-Novice Men:	Top 3 skaters <u>not</u> qualifying for Skate Canada Trophy (Placement 6-8)
Ice Dance:	
Pre-Juvenile:	Top 4 teams
Juvenile:	Top 4 teams
Pre-Novice:	Top 3 teams <u>not</u> qualifying for Skate Canada Trophy
Pairs:	
Juvenile:	Top 4 teams
Pre-Novice:	Top 3 teams <u>not</u> qualifying for Skate Canada Trophy

Wild Cards

Additionally, skaters may qualify for the Skate AB | NT | NU Development Team through wild card placements, as outlined below:

Pre-Juvenile U11, Juvenile U12, U14 Women and Men:

Any skater who achieves a bonus while competing at the Sectional Championship will automatically qualify for the Skate AB | NT | NU Development Team.

Pre-Novice Women and Men:

Skaters who achieve any bonus, in either the short or the free program, while competing at the Sectional Championship will automatically qualify for the Skate AB | NT | NU Development Team.

After the top 3 placements <u>not</u> qualifying for Skate Canada Trophy, AND after any skaters added because of the bonuses, then the next 5 skaters who achieve a combined score greater than 65 points (women) or 50 points (men) while competing at the Sectional Championship <u>AND</u> are U13 as of July 1, 2025, will automatically qualify for the Skate AB | NT | NU Development Team.
