	Skaters are to bring a back-up copy of their music on either a USB or phone/ipod. This device should be clearly labelled with the skaters name and level.
	The host club will be responsible for selecting music for the CanSkate Stage 5 and 6 Spin/Spiral/Jump events. Music will be varied between skaters.
Skater Program Criteria:	Programs shall follow the Skate Canada 2024-2025 well-balanced program criteria as posted on the Skate Canada info at www.info.skatecanada.ca
CanSkate Elements:	 Stage 1 Criteria: Forward push/glide sequence (balance) Forward two-foot jump (agility) Backward two-foot skating/walking (control) Stage 2 Criteria: Forward two-foot sculling (balance) Forward two-foot turn (agility) Backward two-foot to one-foot glide Stage 3 Criteria: Backward two-foot sculling (control) Forward circle thrusts (balance) Backward two-foot jump (agility) Stage 4 Criteria: Forward one-foot turn (agility) Forward crosscuts (balance) Backward circle thrusts (control) Two-foot jump forwards to backwards and backwards to forwards (agility) Stage 5 Criteria: Forward inside edges (balance) Forward power jump (agility) Stage 6 Criteria: Forward outside edges (balance) Forward one-foot side stop (control) Forward one-foot side stop (control) Forward/backward and backward/forward c-steps (agility) Backward perimeter skating with crosscuts (control)

	All elements will be assessed to standard and performed in isolation. All elements must be performed on both feet and in both directions, when applicable.
CanSkate Stage 5 & Stage 6 Spin/Spiral/Jump:	This is a one-minute program to be skated on ½ of the ice surface. The program must include only 1 spin, only 1 jump, and only 1 spiral (in any order). A beginning and ending pose as well as connecting steps may be included.
	Must include:
	 Any forward upright spin Waltz jump or Toe loop One foot spiral (skater's choice)
	Skaters must be working on CanSkate Stage 5 or Stage 6. All programs will be assessed to element standard. Music will be provided by the host club. The music will vary between skaters.

StarSkate 2:	Skaters will perform their trained Star 2 Program to their music and will be assessed based on the Skate Canada criteria for Star 2 Freeskate programs.

Star 2B Canasta Tango Dance:	Skaters will be expected to perform 2 full patterns (one round of the ice) of the Canasta Tango dance. An ending pose is optional.

Star 3A Baby Blues Dance:		Skaters will be expected to perform 2 full patterns (one round of the ice) of the Canasta Tango dance. An ending pose is optional.

Marking System:		Star categories will be judged as per the Skate Canada StarSkate Event Management Guide.
		CanSkate categories will be judged as per the Skate Canada CanSkate Event Management Guide.
Awards:		Skaters will receive a report card and a gold, silver or bronze medal.
