# **General Information**

- 1. **Schedule:** A schedule of events shall be emailed to each club designate prior to the commencement of event.
- Entries: Entrants in the event shall be: Skate Canada registrants in good standing. Event entries will only be accepted from skaters who are members affiliated with Skate Canada Clubs.
- 3. **Entry Fees**: Fees <u>must be paid at time of registration</u> by e-transfer to <u>treasurer@cochraneskatingclub.ca</u>.
- Closing Date of Entries: All entries must be received no later than <u>November 14th, 2025.</u> Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Host Club.
- 5. **Refund of Entry Fees:** No refunds will be made after the closing date. Event fees shall only be refunded due to event cancellation.
- 6. Accidents: The Association and Host Club undertake no responsibility for damages or injuries suffered by the skater. As a condition of and in consideration of their entries in this event, all skaters and parents or guardians shall be deemed to agree to all risks or injuries to the skater's person and property resulting from, or caused by, or connected with the conduct and management of the event. An agreement must also be deemed to release any and all claims they may have against the officials, the Association, the Host Club, and their officers. Entries shall be accepted only in accordance with these conditions.

- 7. **Registration:** Skaters must register one (1) hour prior to the scheduled start time for their event. Skaters must report to the ice captain one (1) hour prior to the scheduled start time of their event.
- 8. Music Submissions: Please email Star 2 and 3 program music to competitions@cochraneskatingclub.ca by no later than November 14, 2025.
  \*Music MUST be in MP3 format and MUST include skaters first and last name. All skaters must also have a back-up option; USB, ipod or phone.
- 9. **Cancellation of Events:** The Host Club reserves the right to cancel any event.
- 10. **Flight System:** If the number of registrations in a category warrant it, a flight system will be used. Skaters will be grouped according to age first and date of registration secondly.
- 11. **Warm Up Times**: Skate Canada has designated standardized warm up times for all events.
- 12. **Awards:** It is the responsibility of skaters to proceed directly to the award presentation area following their skate, wearing skates and skating attire.

# **Creative Improv 1 Events**

\*Skaters will register by free-skate level and be grouped by the same. (Star 1, 2 or 3)

Skaters will hear a piece of music selected by the host club, twice during the warm up; skaters will have the full ice surface to perform a creative program that complements the music. Skaters are encouraged to NOT choreograph routines. Music selections will be a maximum of 45 seconds long and each flight will have a different music selection.

Flight selections will be made according to age and level. Two Program Components will be assessed to standard: **Presentation & Skating Skills**. Skaters do not compete against each other for a ranking since awards are based on performance standards alone.
