Note: Planned program content sheets deadline: December 3, 2025 at 12:00 pm noon MT. To be submitted on Skate Alberta website. (Only needs to be submitted once during the year, changes that need to be made can be done on the invoice in the member's account)

1. All coaches, managers and chaperones must be registered with Skate Canada **in advance** of the competition. Registered coaches, managers and chaperones will need to pick up accreditation at the Registration Desk. No accreditation can be issued at the event.
2. Maximum two coaches and one alternate may stand at the ON Ice gate with the Ice Level Referee. A second coach (if not at the ON gate), team manager and other alternates must be in the exit area/Kiss & Cry. Chaperones are not permitted; they are allowed in the dressing room only.
3. Map of Max Bell is posted with dressing rooms, off and on gates, washrooms, and concessions.

4. Music

Music was submitted with registration.

Each team will be required to carry a copy of their music on USB memory stick and have it available at rink side as backup in a clear bag with team name and category on it. A memory stick may contain all the programs the team is competing in for the competition, however, the programs on the memory stick must be properly digitally labelled to ensure the correct music is played. For example: Team A, Novice Short Program. Each USB must contain music for only one team.

5. Off Ice Warm Up

There is no designated warm up space. There is a track around the seating/spectating area but music cannot be played and voices must be low. You can warm up outside (if weather permits) and some areas in the lobby. No warmups are to occur in entrances or in Arena 2/Perry Cavanagh out of respect for the users of that arena.

6. Results

Report cards and protocols will be available at the competition and posted on the Skate Canada AB/NWT/Nunavut website.

7. Awards and Medal Presentations

Medals and awards for Star 6 and above will be presented on ice immediately after the conclusion of the competition.

During the second-last performance of the evening, **two skaters and one coach** from each team should be in **Change Room 4**, with skaters already wearing skates. Teams may choose to remain in their competition dress or wear team off-ice clothing.

Skaters will be organized to line up in **reverse medal order**, bronze first, then silver, then gold, following the sequence in which the event occurred. Skaters and coach will step onto the ice at the on-gate, cross the ice to the penalty box to receive their medal and exit the ice at the off gate.

The Star 4 awards will be done off ice approximately 30 minutes after the conclusion of the Star 4 category.

8. Report Card Feedback

PROTEST POLICY: Skate Canada Protest Policy for competitions using CPC will be followed. In addition, if there is an event using manual calculation where the results are not posted within one hour of the completion of the last event of the day, the protest must be made to the Event Referee within the first hour of the following days competition. If the Event Referee is unavailable, the protest may be made to the Technical Representative or Chief Referee. Protests are to be submitted through the online form provided on the Skate AB|NT|NU website.

CLARIFICATIONS: clarifications regarding a team's report card may be submitted using the online form provided on the Rose Bowl event page of the Skate AB|NT|NU website. Clarifications are to be submitted through the online form provided on the Skate AB|NT|NU website.

There may be in-person feedback for Gold and Novice at the conclusion of the competition in the Officials' room. We will contact these teams if this is the case.

9. First Aid Volunteer

Located rink side at the off gate. If there is a medical emergency, call 911. First Aid Volunteer has the Emergency Action Plan for the Max Bell Centre.

10. Parking

It is recommended that buses drop off skaters/coaches along the side of the building and then park at the back. There is no charge for parking at this facility.

11. 50/50 and Raffle

This year Rose Bowl will be doing a 50/50 fundraiser through Rafflebox. Link to the 50/50 will be posted on the competition page and around the arena.
