Star Skate 2	<u>Program Event</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Assessed to the standard Introduction to skating, a program in a figure skating event
Star Skate 3	<u>Program Event</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Assessed to the standard Skating a program with increased difficulty
Marking System:	STAR Skate 1-3 will be judged as per the Skate Canada STARSKATE Event Management Guide
Awards:	Skaters will receive a score sheet and a Gold, Silver, or Bronze medal

Warm-Up Times:	Skate Canada has standardized warm-up times for events.

1	Spectators: Spectators are permitted and there are no restrictions. In the event of any restrictions being implemented by the facility, those will be adhered to.
