5. OPEN & CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES:

Entries will open Jan 3, 2026. All entries must be received by no later than February 3, 2026. Skating times will be emailed to the club contact indicated on the Entry Form. (1 contact person per club please) Skaters may skate up a level.

6. ACCIDENTS:

The Association and Committee of the Host Club undertake no responsibility for damages or injuries suffered by the skater. As a condition of and in consideration of their entries in these Events, all skaters and their parents or guardians shall be deemed to agree to assume all risks or injuries to the competitor's person and property resulting from, or caused by, or connected with the conduct and management of the events. An agreement must also be deemed to release any and all claims they may have against the officials, the Association, the Host Club, and their officers. Entries shall be accepted only in accordance with these conditions.

7. REFUND OF ENTRY FEES:

Entry fees shall be refunded only if the event is not held or if the entry is withdrawn before the date of close of entries (Skate Canada Rule 7000-1.5(2)).

9. REGISTRATION ON THE DAY OF THE EVENT

Skaters must be in their assigned dressing rooms 30 minutes before their event. Please check in at the registration desk a minimum of an hour prior to the start of your event. Each event will warm up on the half of the ice surface on which they will be evaluated and then clear the ice until it is their turn to perform. (Warm up time is 3 minutes) except for the STAR 2-3 Freeskate Events which will be on full ice. The Fun Meet will take place between the hours of 8:00 am - 4:00 pm on Saturday, February 21. Star 2-3 Freeskate Events will be run on Friday, Feb 20 if numbers warrant it.

10. CANCELLATION OF EVENTS:

The host club reserves the right to cancel events. The Vermilion Skating Club reserves the right to limit the number of registrations due to time.

10. AWARDS:

It is the responsibility of ALL skaters receiving a medal to wear their skates and skating attire for the medal presentation. Awards will be ongoing all day long. Everyone goes home a winner!

11. PICTURES & VIDEOS: Persons wishing to take photographs of on ice performances are reminded that use of flash cameras is forbidden. The use of video cameras must be restricted to areas that do not hamper the skaters.

NOTE: You may only take pictures or videos of your own skater. No parents will be allowed in the player's box area.

CanSkate Categories- Technical Information

Each skater will complete each of his/her elements before the next skater begins. Elements will be done in circuits from stages 1-4 and one at a time (not in a routine) for stages 5-6.

Note: Skills are integrated; if a skater has passed Stage 1 they would enter Stage 2.

Pre-CanSkate:

- Fall down/stand up
- Move forward
- Fwd 2 ft jump

Stage 1:

- Fwd push/glide sequence
- Fwd 2-ft jump
- Bwd 2-ft skating/walking

Stage 2:

- Fwd 2-ft sculling
- Fwd 2-ft turn (CW or CCW - skater's choice)
- Bwd 2-ft to 1-ft glide

Stage 3:

- Bwd 2-ft sculling
- Fwd circle thrusts (CW or CCW - skater's choice)
- Bwd 2-ft jump

Stage 4:

- Fwd 1-ft turn (to be performed on each foot)
- Fwd crosscuts (to be performed in each direction)
- Bwd circle thrusts or pumps (CW or CCW - skater's choice)
- 2-ft jump fwd to bwd and bwd to fwd* (one jump performed with each foot)

Stage 5:

- Fwd inside edges
- Fwd 2-ft side stop (to be performed in each direction)
- Bwd push/glide sequence, full perimeter (CW or CCW - skater's choice)
- Fwd power jump (one jump performed on each foot)

Stage 6:

- Fwd outside edges
- Fwd 1-ft side stop (execution of a complete stop on each foot)
- Fwd/Bwd and Bwd/Fwd C-steps
- Bwd perimeter skating with crosscuts (CW or CCW - determined by draw)

SPIN SPIRAL JUMP REQUIREMENTS

This is a one minute program to be skated on $\frac{1}{2}$ of the ice surface. Program must include **ONLY** 1 spin, **ONLY** 1 spiral and **ONLY** 1 jump (in any order). A beginning and ending pose as well as connecting steps may be included. **NO MUSIC.** Skaters must be working on CanSkate Stage 5 or 6. The elements will be assessed as a CanSkate circuit at the Stage 5/6 level.

Must include: Any forward upright spin
Waltz jump or Toe loop
One foot spiral (skater's choice)

CANSKATE TEAM ELEMENT EVENT

Each team will consist of 2 to 4 skaters. Skaters will complete skills together from his/her team stage. Skills will be chosen from the above stages. Skills will be done together by each team. Coaches may assist as their skaters, as there will not be use of circuits for this event. Skaters may skate up a stage.

CanSkate Team A (Stage 1/2)

- Fwd push glide sequence
- Forward 2 ft Jump
- Forward 2 ft Sculling
- Backward 2 ft to 1 ft glide

CanSkate Team C (Stage 5/6)

- Fwd 2-foot side stop
- Backward push - glide sequence
- Forward 1ft Side Stop
- Forward Outside Edge

CanSkate Team B (Stage 3/4)

- Forward Circle Thrusts
- Backward 2 ft Sculling
- Backward Circle Thrusts
- Forward 1 ft Turn

Star 1-3 Event Categories- Technical Information

Star 1-3 Element Events

Individual element event. Each skater will perform each element in isolation and skaters will take turns within their group. Skaters must have passed Stage 6 CanSkate but must not have passed Star Level 3.

Star 1 Elements: (performed individually)

Stroking Exercise	Forward Upright Spin
Waltz Jump	Backward Upright Spin
Salchow Jump	Spiral Exercise
Toe Loop Jump	Creative Expression Routine

Star 2 Elements:

Waltz + Toe Loop Combo Jump	Flip Jump
Loop Jump	Loop+Loop Combo Jump
Backward Upright Spin	Combo Spin
Forward Spiral Sequence	Forward Spiral Sequence

Star 3 Elements:

Star 2-3 Freeskate Events

Skaters must have passed Stage 6 CanSkate but must not have passed Star Level 3. Will be performed on full ice.

Level 1-3 Creative Improv Events

Skaters will hear a piece of music selected by the host club twice in warm-up. They will perform a creative routine on the ice to the music selection. Program length is 45 seconds. Skaters must have passed Stage 6 CanSkate. Skaters will be categorized by age and level.

Star 2-3 Team Element Events

Each team will consist of two to four members. Each member will perform on element in isolation. Please fill out a separate registration form for the team event.
