## GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Invitation extended to NWT and Nunavut Region Skating Clubs. Host Club may limit entry numbers.

### 2. CATEGORIES

The following categories are to be held:

Star 1 ELEMENT ASSESSMENT	\$25 per skater
Star 2 FREESKATE PROGRAM	\$25 per skater
Star 3 FREESKATE PROGRAM	\$25 per skater
CanSkate Spin, Spiral, Jump – Stage 5 and 6	\$25 per skater

All Star categories must follow the SKATE CANADA 2025-2026 technical requirements; inclusive of the well balanced program criteria as posted on the Skate Canada Members Info Centre at [Competition Program Requirements - STAR \(skatecanada.ca\)](https://www.skatecanada.ca/competition-program-requirements-star)

### 3. Registration

### 4. Closing Date of Entries

All entries must be received **NO LATER** than Wednesday, April 8 11:59 AM (noon) MST. It is the responsibility of the competitor to ensure that their entry is submitted by the closing date.

5. **Entry Fee:** To be paid in Uplifter.

6. **Event Schedule**

Will be posted on the Yellowknife Skating Club's Facebook page and emailed to skaters.

7. **Refund of Entry Fees**

Entry fees shall be refunded only if the event is not held. There will be no refunds given for any reason, including medical pulls.

8. **Music**

Two copies of the participant's music must be handed in at the Registration Table. Music must be on CDs, and each CD must have only one program on it and must be clearly labelled with skater's name, event, club and length of program. Skaters are responsible for the recovery of their own music at the completion of the event.

9. **On-Site Registration**

Skaters must register a minimum of one hour prior to the start of their scheduled event. Skaters must report to the Ice Captain one hour prior to their scheduled event.

10. **Marking System**

CanSkate Spin, Spiral, Jump EVENT categories will be assessed in accordance with the CanSkate Element Event Technical Package

Star 1-3 will be judged as per the 2025-26 Star Standards for Assessment Guide

11. **Awards / Presentations**

These will be held after every event. It is the responsibility of the skaters to wear their skates & skating attire for the presentations. Please remember to bring your skate guards.

12. **Event Specifications**

CanSkate categories will combine boys and girls by stage and age.

In normal circumstances, Star 1-3 categories offered at competitions will be combined. The decision to combine categories is at the discretion of the Competition Chair with the input of the host committee.

**13. Warm Up Times**

Skate Canada has standardised warm up times for all events.

**14. Accidents**

The Association and Committee of the Host Club undertake no responsibility for damages or injuries suffered by the skater. As a condition of and in consideration of their entries in this event, all competitors and their parents or guardians shall be deemed to release any and all claims they may have against the Officials, the Association, the Host Club and their officers. Entries shall be only in accordance with these conditions.

**15. Pictures & Video**

Persons wishing to take photographs of on ice performances are reminded that the use of flash cameras is NOT permitted. The use of video cameras must be restricted to areas that do not hamper the skater or officials. NOTE: You may ONLY take photos or videos of your own skater.
