- Plan and coordinate our Rising Stars (intro to figure skating) program; create and deliver a comprehensive program that touches on the key areas of agility, balance and control.
- Plan and coordinate our StarSkate program including both on and off ice programming and group classes such as edge class and stroking in coordination with other coaches.
- Support new coaches in achieving credentials.
- Help the head coaching with planning and execution of the annual ice show, including choreography and music arrangement (additional compensation available).
- Work effectively with parents and skaters of all levels to help them achieve personal goals, whether competitive or recreational.
