- Organizing sessions, groups, Program Assistants, and skater progress tracking
- Assisting with team coaching of Star 1–5 skaters (approximately 2–3 days/week)
- Potentially covering additional sessions for other team coaches as needed

PowerSkate certification is considered an asset, but is not required.
