Late Registration Fees:	\$125 for registration after Nov 25, 2026
Entry Fees Refund:	Entry fees will be refunded only if the event is not held or if the entry is withdrawn before the date of the close of entries. There will be a \$10 administration fee applied to all withdrawals. After the closing date of entries (Dec 5), there will be no refunds given for any reason, including medical.

Skater Program Criteria:	Programs shall follow the SKATE CANADA 2026-2027 well-balanced program criteria as posted on the Skate Canada info at www.info.skatecanada.ca StarSkate 2026-2027 StarSkate Competition Program Requirements

STAR 1	<u>Individual Element Event</u> - Assessed to the standard - Introduction to a figure skating event - Focus on individual performance - Elements performed: - Circle Stroking Exercise: Stroking (Crosscuts) in same direction on a circle (one round forward, one round backward); draw for direction - Waltz Jump - Single Salchow - Single Toe Loop - Forward Upright Spin - Backward upward Spin - Forward Spiral circles: Two Spirals, one on each foot executed on a circle in the same direction; skater chooses direction - Creative Expression routine (30 seconds – music provided by the section, selection randomly chosen at competition – each flight to have a different music selection). This is assessed as “completed” or “incomplete” only
STAR 2	<u>Program Event</u> - Assessed to the standard. - Introduction to skating, a program in a figure skating event. <u>Team Event - Teams must be comprised of a minimum of two and a maximum of four skaters.</u> - Assessed to standard. - Each skater will perform one element in isolation in the order listed for their level of competition - Each element may only be attempted once - The first element will be performed by every team in the Event before the second element is performed, and so on - Spins will not be assigned levels and will be assessed on quality only - All skaters will use half-ice to perform the elements: - Single Loop Jump - Waltz Jump + single Toe Loop Jump combination - Backward Upright Spin; minimum three revolutions - Forward Spiral Sequence – two forward spirals, one on each foot performed on either outside or inside edges, no more than eight steps between, both spirals must be unassisted.
STAR 3	<u>Program Event</u> - Assessed to the standard. - Skating a program with increased difficulty. <u>Team Event - Team Event - Teams must be comprised of a minimum of two and a maximum of four skaters.</u> - Assessed to standard. - Each skater will perform one element in isolation in the order listed for their level of competition. - Each element may only be attempted once. - The first element will be performed by every team in the Event before the second element is performed, and so on - Spins will not be assigned levels and will be assessed on quality only.

	• All skaters will use half-ice to perform the elements: ○ Single Flip Jump ○ Single Loop + Single Loop Jump Combination ○ Combination Spin - forward entry only; must include at least one Camel Position and one Sit Position; change of foot optional; no flying entry; no difficult variations; minimum of four revolutions or minimum of three revolutions on each foot if executing change of foot ○ Forward Spiral Sequence - two forward Spirals, one on each foot performed on either outside or inside Edges; no more than four Steps between; both Spirals must be unassisted
Marking System:	Star 1-3 will be judged as per the Skate Canada StarSkate Event Management Guide.
Awards:	Skaters will receive a score sheet and a gold, silver, or bronze medal.
	• It is the responsibility of skaters to wear their skates and skating attire for the medal presentations. • The awards ceremony for each flight will be held approximately 20 minutes after the conclusion of each event in the arena lobby.
Evaluators/Judge:	The event is being held under the current Skate AB NT NU and the Star 1-3 Competition guidelines and will include 1 Skate AB NT NU Judge.
Warm-Up Times:	Skate Canada has standardized warm-up times for events.

Additional Information:	
1	Spectators: Spectators are permitted and there are no restrictions. In the event of any restrictions being implemented by the facility, those will be adhered to.
2	Accidents: The Association and Committee of the Host Club take no responsibility for damages or injuries suffered by the skater. As a condition of and in consideration of their entries in this event, all competitors and their parents or guardians shall be deemed to agree to assume all risks or injuries to the competitor's person and property resulting from, or caused by, or connected with the conduct and management of the competitions. An agreement must also be deemed to release any claims they may have against the officials, the Association, the Host Club, and their officers. Entries shall be accepted only in accordance with these conditions.
3	Pictures and Video: Persons wishing to take photographs of on ice performances are reminded that use of flash cameras is not permitted. The use of video cameras must be restricted to areas that do not disturb or interrupt the skaters or officials. NOTE: You may only take pictures or videos of your own skater.
