1. The Event is being held following the CanSkate Element Technical Package and Star Event Standards for Assessment Guide.

2. **CATEGORIES:**

The following Categories: CanSkate ELEMENTS in Circuit- Stage 1-6
**As per Skate Canada requirement- each group will perform a 30 second creative improv after the last skater has completed their circuit. (30 second practice and 30 second performance)*

3. **ENTRY FEES:**

4. **SCHEDULE OF PRACTICE TIMES AND EVENT SCHEDULE:** A schedule will be emailed out to the club representative.

5. **ENTRIES:** Entrants in Events shall be:
 - a) Be registrants in good standing with Skate Canada.

CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES: All entries must be received no later than **October 30, 2026** Full fee payment by e-transfers must be sent in by this day as well.

LATE ENTRIES: Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Technical Committee. Late entries will be charged an additional \$25.00. Any forms not completely filled out will not be processed!

7. **REFUND OF ENTRY FEES:** Entry fees shall be refunded only if the event is not held or if the entry is withdrawn before the date of close. No refunds will be made after October 30, 2026.
8. **ACCIDENTS:** The Association and Committee of the Host Club undertake no responsibility for damages or injuries suffered by the skater. As a condition of and in consideration of their entries in these Championships, all competitors and their parents or guardians shall be deemed to agree to assume all risks or injuries to the competitor's person and property resulting from, or caused by, or connected with the

conduct and management of the competitions. An agreement must also be deemed to release any and all claims they may have against the officials, the Association, the Host Club, and their officers. Entries shall be accepted only in accordance with these conditions.

9. ON-LINE REGISTRATION: Opens- October 13th

Team Event Registration and Fees -

We ask that one person register all team members of the team, up to 4 skaters. You will need skater's names, birthdates, Skate Canada numbers and team name to register. Simply add skaters to the drop-down menu when registering, the \$10 fee per skater will be added to your cart.

Payment upon check-out will be by Credit Card only

10. **REGISTRATION on the DAY OF THE EVENT:** Skaters must be in their assigned dressing rooms 30 minutes before their event. Please check in at the registration desk a minimum of an hour prior to the start of your event.
11. **CANCELLATION OF EVENTS:** The host club reserves the right to cancel events due to time. The Bonnyville Skating Club reserves the right to limit the number of registrations.
12. **AWARDS:** Awards will be ongoing all day long. Everyone on goes home a winner!
13. **PICTURES & VIDEOS:** Persons wishing to take photographs of on ice performances are reminded that use of flash cameras is forbidden. The use of video cameras must be restricted to areas that do not hamper the skaters.
14. **NOTE:** You may only take pictures or videos of your own skater. No parents will be allowed in the player's box area.

CanSkate CATEGORIES

A. CanSkate Elements

Stage 1- Stage 6 will perform these elements as a circuit.

Note: Skills are integrated; if a skater has passed Stage 1 they would enter Stage 2

All Skaters will do a creative expression when the last skater finishes.

Stage 1:

Forward push/glide sequence

Two-foot jump on a spot

Backward two-foot skating/walking

Stage 2:

Forward two-foot sculling

Forward to Backward 2-foot turn

Backward two-foot to one foot glide

Stage 3:

Backwards two-foot sculling

Forward circle thrusts

Backward two-foot jump with glide

Stage 4:

Forward 1 foot turn (each foot)

Forward Crosscuts

Backward Circle Thrusts or pumps

Forward to backward 2-foot jump and backward to forward 2-foot jump

Stage 5:

Forward Inside Edges

Forward 2-foot side stop (each direction)

Backward push glide sequence

Forward power jump (each foot)

Stage 6:

Forward Outside Edges

Forward 1 foot side stop (each foot)

Forward to backward C Step and backward to forward C Step

Backward perimeter skating with crosscuts

B TEAM EVENT

Each team will consist of minimum 2 skaters and maximum of 4 skaters. Each skater will complete one skill from his/her team stages. Skills will be chosen from the above stages. In the event that a team only consists of 3 skaters, one skater will complete 2 skills.

Team Members will not be added once a team is registered.

Team levels are as follows:

Stage 1 and Stage 2,
Stage 3 and Stage 4,
Stage 5 and Stage 6

CanSkate Team A (Stage 1/2)

Forward push glide sequence
Forward 2 ft Jump
Forward 2 ft Sculling
Backward 2 foot to 1 foot glide

CanSkate Team B (Stage 3/4)

Forward Circle Thrusts
Backward 2 ft Sculling
Backward Circle Thrusts or pumps
Forward 1 foot turn (each foot)

CanSkate Team A (Stage 5/6)

Forward 2-Foot side stop (each direction)
Backward push – glide sequence
Forward 1 ft Side Stop (each direction)
Forward Outside Edges

STAR 1-3 Event Categories- Technical Information

STAR 1-3 Event Categories for Elements

Technical Information STAR 1-3 Element Events Individual element event. Each skater will perform each element in isolation and skaters will take turns within their group. Skaters must have passed Stage 6 CanSkate but must not have passed Star Level 3.

STAR 1 Elements:

Stroking Exercise
Waltz Jump
Salchow Jump
Toe Loop
Upright Spin (fwd)
Backward Upright Spin
Forward Spiral Sequence
Creative Expression Routine

STAR 2 Elements:

Waltz + Toe Loop
Loop
Backward Upright Spin
Forward Spiral Sequence

STAR 3 Elements

Flip
Loop + Loop Combo
Combo Spin
Forward Spiral Sequence

STAR 2-3 Event Categories for Freeskate

Skaters must have passed Stage 6 CanSkate but must not have passed STAR Level 3.

STAR 2 Freeskate Program Event (please email skater music to bonnyvilleskatinginfo@gmail.com and include the Skaters name and level in the Subject Line)

Skaters will perform their trained STAR 2 Program with their music and be assessed on the following criteria:

Jumps in Program	Skating Skills
Spins in Program	Performance and Execution
Spiral Sequence	Interpretation

STAR 3 Freeskate Program Event (please email skater music to bonnyvilleskatinginfo@gmail.com and include the Skaters name and level in the Subject Line) Music selection must be in mp3 format.

Skaters will perform their trained STAR 3 Program with their music and be assessed on the following criteria:

Jumps in Program	Skating Skills
Spins in Program	Performance and Execution
Spiral Sequence	Interpretation

STAR 2-3 Event Categories for Team

Each team will consist of two to four members. Each member will perform on element in isolation.

Team Members will not be added once a team is registered.

STAR 2 Team Elements:

Waltz + Toe Loop
Loop Jump
Backward Upright Spin
Forward Spiral Sequence

STAR 3 Team Elements:

Flip Jump
Loop + Loop Jump Combo
Combo Spin
Forward Spiral Sequence

STAR 2/3 Pattern Dance Solo:

Skaters must have passed the STAR 1 Dance Assessment. Skate Canada series 8 music will be played. If a skater wants to use an ISU version, they must submit their music to the Club Event Contact before November 12th.

We will offer- STAR 2/3 Canasta Dance and STAR 2/3 Baby Blues Dance

Creative Improv 1

Creative Improv 1 – Skaters must have passed the STAR 1 assessment in any discipline

Skaters will hear a piece of music selected by the host club twice in warm- up.

They will perform a creative routine on the ice to the music selection.

NO COACHING PERMITTED DURING THIS EVENT.

Skaters that have already competed in a STAR 4 event or higher are ineligible to enter into the STAR 1-3 events.
