Entries: Entrants in these events shall be:

- a) Eligible persons as defined by the Skate Canada Playbook
- b) Be members in good standing of Skate Canada. Entries will only be accepted from skaters that are members of affiliated Skate Canada clubs.

Closing Date of Entries: All entries must be completed online not later than October 31, 2026.

Late Entries: Late entries are subject to a \$25 late penalty fee.

Refund of Entry Fees: Entry fees shall be refunded only if the event is not held. There will be no refunds given for any reason, including medical pulls. No exceptions will be made.

Registration on the Day of the Event: Skaters must register at least one hour prior to their scheduled event.

Schedule and Cancellation of Events: The host club reserves the right to cancel or limit the number of entries due to time constraints or ice availability. The schedule will be sent out by email.

Warm-up Times: All scheduled on-ice warm-ups will be 3 minutes in length.

Accidents: The association and committee of the host club undertake no responsibility for damages, or injuries suffered by the skater. As a condition of and in consideration of their entries in these events, all skaters and their parents/guardians shall be deemed to agree to assume all risks or injuries to the skaters person and property resulting from, or caused by, or connected with the conduct and management of events. An agreement must be deemed to release any and all claims they may have against the officials, the association, the host club, and their officers. Entries shall be accepted only in accordance with these conditions.

Awards: Skaters will receive a Gold, Silver, or Bronze medal. The awards ceremony for each flight will be held approximately 20 minutes after the conclusion of each event in the awards area. All team event skaters will receive Gold, Silver, or Bronze medal.

Music Submission:

- All music must be submitted to [devonskatingmusic@icloud.com](mailto:devonskatingmusic@icloud.com) before November 7, 2026.
- Music must be saved in an MP3 format.
- Skaters should bring a back-up copy of their music on a USB or phone/ipod.

### Team Event Registration:

- All skaters who are to participate on a team are to register for the event. The coach/parent team representative is to then submit the team name and skaters to [devonskatingcoaches@gmail.com](mailto:devonskatingcoaches@gmail.com) by November 7, 2026.

### **CanSkate Element Events:**

\*Elements are to be skated on a circuit and will be assessed to standard as laid out by Skate Canada. Coaches and/or Program Assistants are welcome to lead the skaters through the circuit.

\*Following the last skater in each group, all skaters in the group will complete a 30 second Creative Improv performance. Skaters will have a 30 second practice prior to the performance.

#### Stage 3:

- Backward two-foot sculling (Control) - minimum 6 sculls
- Forward circle thrusts (Balance) - CW & CCW
- Backward two-foot jump (Agility)

#### Stage 4:

- Forward one-foot turn (Agility) - Right & left foot
- Forward crosscuts (Balance) - CW & CCW
- Backward circle thrusts (Control) - CW & CCW
- Two-foot jump forward to backwards and backwards to forwards (Agility)

#### Stage 5:

- Forward inside edges (Balance) - Right & left foot
- Forward two-foot side stop (Control) - each direction
- Backward push glide sequence (Control)
- Forward power jump (Agility) - Right & left foot

#### Stage 6:

- Forward outside edges (Balance) - Right & left foot
- Forward one-foot side stop (Control) - Right & left foot
- Forward/backward and backward/forward C-steps (Agility)
- Backward perimeter skating with crossovers (Control)

### **CanSkate Team Element Events:**

Team Event Registration:

- All skaters who are to participate on a team are to register for the event. The coach/parent team representative is to then submit the team name and skaters to [devonskatingcoaches@gmail.com](mailto:devonskatingcoaches@gmail.com) by November 7, 2026.

\*Elements are to be skated as elements in isolation and will be assessed to standard as laid out by Skate Canada.

#### Stage 3/4:

- Backward two-foot sculling (Control) - minimum 6 sculls
- Forward circle thrusts (Balance) - CW & CCW
- Forward one-foot turn (Agility) - Right & left foot
- Two-foot jump forward to backwards and backwards to forwards (Agility)

#### Stage 5/6:

- Forward two-foot side stop (Control) - each direction
- Forward power jump (Agility) - Right & left foot
- Forward outside edges (Balance) - Right & left foot
- Forward one-foot side stop (Control) - Right & left foot

### **Showcase 1 Event:**

\* Each skater will perform a 1:00-minute program (plus or minus 10 seconds) on the full ice surface. A beginning and ending pose and connecting steps may be included. Music must be provided by the skater. Program Components will be Assessed as per Skate Canada's Showcase 1.

\*All program music must be emailed to [devonskatingmusic@icloud.com](mailto:devonskatingmusic@icloud.com) prior to November 7, 2026.

\*Skaters must have passed a STAR 1 assessment in any discipline, prior to participating. Skaters from STAR 1-3 are eligible to participate.

- Loop Jump
- Backward Upright Spin
- Forward Spiral Sequence

### STAR 3 Elements

- Flip Jump
- Loop Loop Combination Jump
- Combination Spin
- Forward Spiral Sequence

### **STAR Program Events:**

#### STAR 2 & 3 Programs

\*All programs must follow the Skate Canada well balanced program criteria as posted on the Skate Canada info page: [www.info.skatecanada.ca](http://www.info.skatecanada.ca). All programs will be assessed to standard.

\*All program music must be emailed to [devonskatingmusic@icloud.com](mailto:devonskatingmusic@icloud.com) prior to November 7, 2026.

### **Creative Improv 1:**

\*Each skater must perform a program of their design with minimal preparation. There is no coaching permitted for these events. Creative Improv tests the skater's ability to quickly interpret a piece of music and entertain the audience.

\*All skaters must have completed a STAR 1 assessment in any discipline prior to participating. Skaters from STAR 1-3 are eligible to participate.

Program content, rules, and event procedures are the same for all levels:

- Skaters will listen to the music twice on-ice during the warm-up period.
- Each flight will receive a different piece of music, and music will not be disclosed before the flight's warm-up.
- All skaters in each flight will perform to the same music selection, selected by the Devon Skating Club.
- All single jumps are permitted. Any jumps of higher rotation will be subject to an illegal element violation if included.
- Skaters will be categorized by age and level.

- Each program will be 30 seconds in length and will be performed on full ice.

### **STAR Team Elements Events:**

#### Team Event Registration:

- All skaters who are to participate on a team are to register for the event. The coach/parent team representative is to then submit the team name and skaters to [competition@devonskating.com](mailto:competition@devonskating.com) by November 7, 2026.
- STAR 1 skaters are welcome to participate on a STAR 2 team.

\*all STAR team elements will be performed on the half ice surface. Teams are to be comprised of two to four skaters. Each skater will perform 1-2 elements in isolation. Skaters are encouraged to dress up in their theme as a team.

- Loop Jump
- Waltz Toe Loop Combo Jump
- Backward Upright Spin
- Forward Spiral Sequence

#### STAR 3 Elements

- Flip Jump
- Loop Loop Combination Jump
- Combination Spin
- Forward Spiral Sequence

### **Showcase 1 Team Event:**

\* Teams are comprised of 2-6 skaters. Each team will perform a 1:00-minute program (plus or minus 10 seconds) on the full ice surface. A beginning and ending pose and connecting steps may be included. Music must be provided by the skater. Program Components will be Assessed as per Skate Canada's Showcase 1.
